## Neighborhood Energy Saver (NES) Program Overview

#### Goals:

- Help customers better manage their energy usage and save money on their energy bills.
- Work with local leaders and vendors to build neighborhood engagement and conduct energy assessments, energy-saving improvements, and participant education at no cost.

#### Objectives:

- Assist households in income eligible neighborhoods by installing up to 20 FREE energy improvements.
- Educate households on energy efficiency techniques and best practices.
- Change the way customers think about using energy.
- Control energy usage.

## **NES Eligibility Requirements**

- Meet the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity income guidelines
- Single family homes and apartments are eligible
- Homeowners and Renters are eligible
- Duke Energy residential metered customer
- Reside in the selected census data block group
- If customers participated in a previous Energy Efficiency Program, they are still eligible, but only under the terms of the NES program. Duke Energy will not provide a rebate or incentivize work completed on those programs.

  - Direct contact information of the program manager if there are questions.




## Community Kick off Meeting – Town of Eatonville

- Collaboration with Town of Eatonville staff to get flyers disseminated and messaging out via town channels




