



# CEMETERY COMMITTEE MEETING

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## MINUTES

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The Cemetery Committee met in City Council Chambers on Thursday, November 17, 2022. Vice President, Phyllis Ellison, called the meeting to order at 6:05 P.M. Minutes of the October meeting were read and approved. A new member approved by City Council was welcomed. She is Brenda Ramirez. Omar Saldibar was present and he must fill out paperwork for the City Council to approve him as a member of this committee.

Paula Duwe presented an informational report on the development of roads at the cemetery she had gathered speaking to Laura Beeson and Ronnie Winans of the City. She also garnered information from Kyle Gould, an estimator with Reece Albert in San Angelo. She shared information she received for TXDOT manager, Israel Ortegon, here in the city as well. Kyle Gould gave Paula a projected amount of money that the road repairs about which she was asking would cost. The amount was \$158,000. Brenda commented that one of the roads in the cemetery covered graves from the past.

Phyllis reported that she had contacted Drew Darby's office in Austin. She had spoken with a lady named Sheryl. That woman did online research for the Eden Cemetery. It should have been on the state website. No Eden Cemetery was found. All that was located was the Old Eden Cemetery. No one knows exactly where that is located.

A discussion was held regarding the \$100,000 held in a trust in the Eden State Bank. Some research needs to be done regarding the trust. Information needed is how the trust is set up and is there a way to get around the trust.

The only new business was to declare there would be no meeting in December due to the busyness of the Christmas season. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, January 19, 2023 at 6:00 P.M.
