**Escondido Union High School District Student Mural Submissions**

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Request the Grants Subcommittee provide direction on the 20 submissions received for the Escondido Union High School District Student Murals.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

As part of the Public Art Annual Work Plan 2025/2026, the Public Art Commission has allocated up to \$15,000 for the Escondido Union High School District Student Murals program.

**BACKGROUND:**

On July 14, 2025, the Public Art Commission voted to approve (7-0) the Public Art Annual Work Plan 2025/2026 which includes the category of art education. The Public Art Commission allocated \$15,000 for the continuation of the partnership with Escondido Union High School District to have students, with supervision and aid from their art teacher to paint murals on City buildings during the summer. This partnership, ongoing for five consecutive summers, will be entering its sixth year in summer of 2026.

Three locations were given as potential options for murals. The Park Avenue Community Center has two possible locations. An exterior wall that faces south to the parking lot and road and a second outdoor patio wall that also faces south, both which are currently blank. For these two locations, the theme of Flora and Fauna was suggested. The third location is in the east facing wall of Washington Park Recreation Building near the entry door. On February 3, 2026, City staff received 20 designs for consideration.
