City Manager Craig Spencer stated that the number for the concept drawing that they have done came in too high and we are working on scaling that down to a lower number for the cost. Craig also stated that there is several people in staff working on this grant so that we can get monies through that for the Shelter. This is always a process and he will keep them updated with the process and to when it is done. The current design that is drawn up for the concept is at 1.8 million dollars.

At this time it is brought to the Board to let us know what they would like to see on the agenda. Craig also asked about how many times a year they want to meet. Currently we have to meet three times a year.
