**WHEREAS**, America’s founding principles of liberty, equality, justice, and opportunity have inspired generations of citizens and continue to guide our nation through times of challenge and progress; and

**WHEREAS**, the Semiquincentennial, known nationally as America 250, provides an opportunity to reflect upon our nation’s history, honor the sacrifices of those who have defended and preserved our freedoms, and celebrate the diverse contributions of all Americans who have helped shape our country; and

**WHEREAS**, communities across the nation are joining together to recognize this historic milestone through civic engagement, education, service, remembrance, and celebration; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Everman proudly recognizes the enduring spirit of patriotism, service, and community that has defined our nation for 250 years and continues to strengthen our community today; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Everman encourages all residents to participate in America 250 commemorative activities, learn more about our nation’s history, honor our veterans and service members, and celebrate the freedoms and opportunities that unite us as Americans.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVERMAN, TEXAS**, that July 4, 2026, is hereby proclaimed as “AMERICA 250 DAY” in the City of Everman, Texas, and the City Council encourages all citizens to recognize and celebrate the 250<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the United States of America

**RESOLUTION NO. 2026-06-01**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVERMAN, TEXAS, AUTHORIZING A FIREWORKS DISPLAY IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY OF EVERMAN'S CELEBRATE AMERICA FESTIVAL; AUTHORIZING THE FIRE CHIEF TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS TO FACILITATE THE EVENT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Everman annually hosts community events and celebrations that promote civic pride, community engagement, and family-friendly entertainment; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Everman will host the Celebrate America Festival on June 29, 2026, in recognition of Independence Day and the America 250 commemoration; and

**WHEREAS**, a professionally conducted fireworks display serves as a highlight of the festival and provides residents and visitors an opportunity to celebrate our nation's heritage in a safe and organized manner; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that authorizing a fireworks display as part of the Celebrate America Festival serves a valid public purpose and promotes the cultural and recreational interests of the community; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council desires to authorize the Fire Chief to coordinate and facilitate the fireworks display and ensure compliance with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, permits, and safety requirements.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EVERMAN, TEXAS:**

**SECTION 1.**

The City Council hereby authorizes the conducting of a professional fireworks display in conjunction with the City of Everman's Celebrate America Festival to be held on June 29, 2026.

**SECTION 2.**

The Fire Chief, or his designee, is authorized to coordinate, facilitate, and oversee the fireworks display and to execute any necessary permits, applications, operational documents, and related actions necessary for the safe conduct of the event.

**SECTION 3.**

The fireworks display shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, permit requirements, fire codes, and safety standards.

**SECTION 4.**

The City Council finds that this Resolution serves a public purpose by promoting community engagement, civic pride, and celebration of the nation's 250th anniversary.

**SECTION 5.**

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
