POSSIBLE COUNCIL ACTION: Motion to approve a construction contract with A&K Earthmovers of Fallon, Nevada in order to complete the Fallon Municipal Airport Reconstruct East Portion of Taxilanes project, PWP-CH-2024-246, in the amount of One Million One Hundred Sixty-Nine Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-Two Dollars and Zero Cents (\$1,169,482.00) , of which the FAA share would be 93.75% or One Million Ninety-Six Thousand Three Hundred and Eighty-Nine Dollars and Thirty-Eight Cents (\$1,096,389.38) and the City’s share would be 6.25% or Seventy-Three Thousand Ninety-Two Dollars and Sixty-Three Cents (\$73,092.63).

DISCUSSION: The City has been approved for an FAA grant to complete the Reconstruct East Portion of Taxilanes project at the Fallon Municipal Airport. This project was previously designed by J-U-B Engineers, Inc. Sealed bids for FY 2024 Airport Improvements to the Fallon Municipal Airport were received and opened at 3:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 2, 2024. Based on available funding, it is anticipated that only Base Bid Schedule A – Reconstruct East Portion of Taxilanes will be awarded. The bid submitted by A&K Earth Movers, Inc. is the apparent low bid for Base Bid Schedule A. Should additional funding become available, including through award of funding pursued under the FY 2023 Supplemental

Discretionary Funding Opportunity, the City of Fallon concurs with J-U-B Engineers to award subsequent bid schedules as funding permits.

City staff recommends approval of a construction contract with A&K Earthmovers as the lowest responsive and responsible bidder.

Dear Mr. Byrd:

Sealed bids for FY 2024 Airport Improvements to the Fallon Municipal Airport were received and opened at 3:00 PM on April 2, 2024. The project consisted of five bid schedules, though only the base bid is expected to be awarded. While only the Base Bid was used to determine the lowest bid, the low bidder on the Base Bid was also the low bidder on all bid schedules. In conformance of FAA AIP Handbook-Order 5100.38D, below is a “Price Analysis” for the total bid price.

**Price Analysis:**

Two sealed bids were received and are summarized in the following tables:

The overall low bidder, A&K Earth Movers, submitted a base bid that was 11.9% higher than the Engineer’s Estimate and a total bid that was 6.0% lower than the Engineer’s Estimate. The bid submitted by A&K Earth Movers was also 19.2% lower and 21.6% lower than the next closest bid on base bid and total bid. The average of the two base bids was \$1,293,449.50 (21.9% higher) and the average of the two total bids was \$2,742,369.50 (5.5% higher).

The unit prices for each bid item varied between bids as seen in the attached Bid Summary spreadsheet. Generally, A&K Earth Movers was lower than Granite on Mobilization, Subbase Course, and Aggregate Base Course on all bid schedules, which is due to their closer proximity to the airport and the local availability of aggregate sources owned and operated by A&K Earth Movers.

The primary difference noted between the Engineer's Estimate and the bid prices provided by A&K Earth Movers was also seen in the Subbase Course and Aggregate Base Course items. While these unit prices provided by A&K were lower than those provided by Granite, they were still higher than expected for material sources located near Fallon compared to those located in the Reno area that were utilized by Granite. While the unit prices were higher than expected, they should still be considered reasonable based on the current bidding environment as evidenced by several other similar projects in the area.

Enclosed is a copy of the bid package for your files. Based on several comparisons in the current market climate and the additional considerations listed above, J-U-B finds the apparent low bid submitted by A&K Earth Movers, Inc. to be competitive, fair and reasonable in accordance with FAA AIP Handbook-Order 5100.38D.

The bid submitted by A&K Earth Movers, Inc. was reviewed for bid submittal requirements and appears to be responsive. This company is a qualified licensed contractor in the State of Nevada and has a history of performing similar projects. Based on the bidding criteria, A&K Earth Mover's bid is considered responsive and responsible.


A&K Earth Movers is not a DBE contractor and did not list any DBE subcontractors.

Based on the current available funding, J-U-B recommends award of Base Bid Schedule A to A&K Earth Movers. Additional funding is being pursued through the FY 2023 Supplemental Discretionary Funding Opportunity for the remaining bid schedules. Should additional funding be secured, J-U-B recommends award of additional bid schedules as funding allows. J-U-B finds that the other four bid schedules are also competitive, fair, and reasonable in accordance with FAA AIP Handbook-Order 5100.38D.

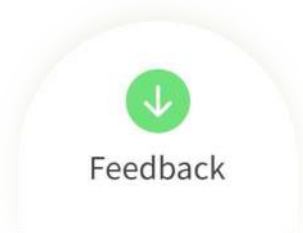

**POSSIBLE COUNCIL ACTION:** Motion to approve Amendment 1 to the Stampede Energy Exchange Services Agreement, extending the contract term and value calculation.

**DISCUSSION:** Since 2007, the City of Fallon has been a party to an Agreement between the United States Department of Energy Western Area Power Administration (“WAPA”) and The Truckee Donner Public Utility District (“Truckee Donner”) wherein the City’s entitlements to energy generated by the Stampede Power Project is assigned to Truckee Donner. The proposed Amendment 1 to the contract extends the term of the Agreement to December 31, 2044. Additionally, Amendment 1 modifies the value calculation for energy produced by the Stampede Project from 75% of the Intercontinental Exchange Mid-C price index to the on-peak/off-peak Stampede Generation LMP price from the California Independent System Operator. Lastly, the Amendment updates the contact provisions to the Agreement to the current representatives of the agencies thereto.

Truckee Donner Public Utility District (TDPUD), City of Fallon (Fallon) and Western Area Power Administration (WAPA) are parties to the Stampede Energy Exchange Account (SEEA) Agreement, WAPA Contract 07-SNR-01026. The SEEA Agreement provides for TDPUD/Fallon to take the Stampede generation and pay directly into the SEEA for the generation. TDPUD manages the SEEA and pays the utility bills of the project use facilities associated with the Stampede Powerplant with funds from the SEEA.
