AN ORDINANCE

AN ORDINANCE BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF FOREST PARK, GEORGIA, TO ADOPT A BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR, ENDING JUNE 30, 2022; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES; BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FOREST PARK AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE AUTHORITY OF SAME THAT:

<u>Section 1:</u> The annual budget for the operations, capital projects, grant programs and debt service for the city for the Fiscal Year ending June 30, 2022, is \$31,733,749. The budget includes all revenues and expenditures for governmental and enterprise purposes as detailed in the accompany budget documents herein incorporated is hereby adopted in accordance with Georgia Law. Item #1.

<u>Section 2</u>: This ordinance shall become effective immediately and the budget shall be implemented for the Fiscal Year of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022.

<u>Section 3:</u> Repealer – All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Severability – In the event any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance shall be declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall in no matter effect the other section, subsections, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect as if the section, subsections, sentence, clause, or phrase so declared to be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional were not a part hereof. The Council hereby declares that it would not have passed the remaining parts of this ordinance if it had known that such part or parts hereof would be declared or adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.
