Jansen explained the boulders are planned to be placed in the July 8th time frame. D. Thomas said they have had the docks for years and wanted to know the plan. C. Letourneau said the money has been in the budget for the last two years. It has been an issue of lining up the engineers and getting the stuff done. D. Thomas said it has been a while and they are receiving complaints. C. Rosenquist asked if anyone had reached out to a dock specialist. C. Letourneau said that T. Cadieux was reaching out. D. Thomas reported that T. Cadieux told him via e-mail that they did not have the money to install them. C. Rosenquist and C. Letourneau confirmed that they did have the money and it was put in the budget. P. Jansen clarified that they did not know how or who would install them. P. Jansen said he reached out to St. Albans Bay Marina who said the docks that we have are not the same as the ones they have there.
