HOW THE RELIEF ASSOCIATION IS FUNDED

- \$5,000 CONTRIBUTION FROM CITY OF GRAND RAPIDS
- 2% MONIES COLLECTED ON INSURANCE PREMIUMS BY THE STATE OF MINNESOTA \$191,000
- THE RELIEF ASSOCIATION FUND IS \$4.8 MILLION AS OF NOVEMBER 2025
