




10 YEAR CALL VOLUME FROM


CITY/MUTUAL AID COMPARED TO TOWNSHIP CALLS




COMPARISON OF CITY TO TOWNSHIP CALLS FOR THE LAST 10 YEARS

INCIDENTS BY DISTRICT






INCIDENTS BY MONTH



Location of Rental Licenses




