WHAT TO EXPECT AT THIS STAGE



1. The Draft Phase Surfaces Disagreement

Earlier engagement focused on ideas and values. Now, with a draft, people react to specific words, maps, and policies, which can lead to disagreement and pushback. This is normal and signals the plan is taken seriously, not a sign of trouble.

2. Comments will be more focused, louder, and more polarized

Fewer "blue sky" ideas and stronger positions. Some groups will advocate hard for their interests, while others may oppose elements they previously supported once tradeoffs are clear.

3. Staff will be asking clearer yes-or-no policy questions

This phase requires decisions. Feedback is used to refine, adjust, or defend policy direction: not to restart the process. Not every comment results in a change, and that is intentional.

4. Expect iteration, not perfection

The draft will develop further during this period. Feedback will improve clarity and align with the Community. The main goal is to create a legally sound, clearly written Growth Policy, not to achieve complete community consensus.

WHAT DO WENEED FROM YOU?

1. The Growth Policy Draft will be published to the public for comment on January 12th for 45 days – READ IT:

The draft reflects the past year and a half of public input, technical analysis, and policy discussion. Reviewing the entire document, including the maps and policy language, is necessary to provide informed and constructive feedback. Comments based only on general impressions or section headings are less helpful at this stage, as meaningful input requires familiarity with the draft.

2. Remember this is a DRAFT, not the final product

This is a draft, not the final word. If something does not sit right or seems to be missing, speak up. That kind of feedback helps strengthen the policy and should not be taken as a personal or intentional shortcoming.

3. There Will Be Additional Opportunities for Public Input

After the public comment period, there will still be additional opportunities to be heard. If you think the draft needs changes or believe it is right on the mark, you can share your input at a public hearing before the Planning Advisory Board, which will consider whether to recommend approval or denial. The City Commission will then hold its own public hearing and make the final decision on adoption.

4. Get the word out and SHARE!

Help spread the word. The draft will be shared through social media and other outreach efforts. Please also share it with neighbors, colleagues, and community groups so more people are aware of the opportunity to review and comment.
