5. **Solid Waste Collection:** - Carlos Cedeno, Public Works Director.

City Manager explained SW was impacted by Covid and their personnel was lower.

Pearce stated he Staff and discussed some of the issues with Advance Disposal.

He presented photos of the results of lack of pickups and garbage piling up. He also stated one of the main issues was the lack of communication between Advance Disposal, the City, and community. The second was lack of backup vehicles. The third was the lack of staffing.

City Manager McCue discussed there were productive talks on the expectations and future service by Advance Disposal. However, if there was continuous lack of service the City was obliged to revisit the contract.

Mayor Flores also wanted better communication.

City Manager discussed Advance Disposal adopting more efficient pickup times for our residents.

Ms. Ellen Smith, Governor Affairs Director for Advance, she stated the situation in the photos was unacceptable. She stated there was productive conversation. Advance Disposal would implement better shifts and quality assurance. She asked for a monthly meeting between the City and Advance Disposal to address and improve quality pickup.

Mayor Flores thanked Ms. Smith.
