### PRESENTATION: DR. L. OLIVER ROBINSON, SUPERINTENDENT OF SHENENDEHOWA CENTRAL SCHOOL DISTRICT, 2025-2026 SCHOOL BUDGET.

Dr. Robinson: Thank you Supervisor Tollisen, it is always a pleasure to join you and to give you an update on the school budget. I have with me here today, Dr. Cecily Wilson-Turner, and we enjoy coming to the Town of Halfmoon, not only for the treats, but because the Town Board has always been welcoming to us, and I would like to thank the entire board for that. I will be retiring at the end of this school year, so after 30 plus years with 20 at Shen, I will be starting the next chapter. This is my twentieth time here reporting on the budget, and our focus is the same, that the new school year will be as good or better than the school year before, keeping in mind the tax implications to our community. The budget we put out this year is around 4.4 percent increase, and the tax implication for most will be flat. The budget vote will be on May 20th with the first referendum being the budget, the second, a vote on the purchase of buses. I am waiting to hear from the State about mandates on the electric buses, as we are looking to purchase two additional electric buses. The last and certainly not the least, we have three seats on the Board of Education for re-election, with two incumbents running. We urge you to come out and vote, the voting will be held at the Gowana Middle School on May 20th, and if you cannot make it out to the polls, as for an Absentee Ballot. Many forget that these are available and to ask for one. So please ask for one to exercise your civic responsibility. The last piece I would like to talk about is that we will be celebrating our 75th anniversary of Shenendehowa Central School District. The celebration will take place on Saturday May 17<sup>th</sup> and will be from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm. with a wide variety of activities. The Halfmoon Town Historian, Lynda Bryan, has been involved in helping us with gathering that wonderful history. It's going to be a great time. I am going to end as I started, I want to thank you all, it has been a pleasure coming here the past 20 years, and these are the things I will miss most about my job. If anyone has questions, I would be happy to answer them at this time.
