#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The Crime Comparison by Quarter Report (**Exhibit A**) has been updated by the addition of the 4<sup>th</sup> Quarter of 2025. The report is only through December 21, 2025. *Person Crimes*, at 3 this last quarter, are more serious crimes. This included an arrest for an assault in the 4<sup>th</sup> degree, a fight between two juveniles, and a sexual assault still under investigation.

*Property crimes*, as sometimes normal during the holidays, have increased. There was one shoplifting, and one investigation of theft/larceny. Four vehicle thefts, included stolen license plates, a ball hitch, \$10 in snacks, and one theft less than \$100. A juvenile was arrested for burglary, and a contractor lost \$200 to \$300 in tools at a construction site. A vehicle theft turned out to be a disagreement about financial agreements, but unfortunately, another resident lost about \$2,098 due to a book publishing scam.

*Drug/Alcohol Crimes* are 3 this quarter. One was a frequent offender arrested for a probation violation, who was lodged at Lane County Jail; she was cited in lieu of custody for unlawful possession of meth. An investigation into a drug offense was

started, and another frequent offender in Harrisburg was arrested for criminal trespass II and unlawful possession of meth.

*All other offenses* are 17. This included a citation in lieu of custody for a warrant out of our Municipal Court, a fugitive warrant citation during a traffic stop, and a simple trespass in the high school due to several juveniles who were 'exploring' at 11:34pm on a Monday night before a holiday. During one fugitive warrant, a deputy found a juvenile runaway, while another runaway was investigated. Two of the arrests above had multiple offenses (one who was trespassed from City property had five total offenses during this period) and are included on this list. There were 5 fugitive warrants for arrests, and 2 disorderly conducts, and at least two littering charges that were added to other charges.

*Arrests*, may not be accurate in the program this month. It looks as though there were 7 arrests for property crimes, out of 12 committed during this quarter. The difficulty lies in the program, as it repeats the same language for each location. (Deputy begins theft investigation). Likewise, all other offenses may not be accurate. Staff has asked Sergeant Frambes to verify the information. If LCSO had 7 arrests out of 12 thefts committed, then that is a great stat that should be commended.

*Citations* were the same as the last quarter at 41. *Total violations* dropped to 48 from 71. There were 2 *non-injury crashes*, and no data under *injury crashes*. *Moving violations* increased to 8, while *speeding* only increased by 2. *Licensed/insurance violations* was decreased from 33 to 17, and *equipment violations* dropped by 6 from the previous quarter.

In the YTD Crimes compared to last year (**Exhibit B**, Page 4), Council can see that in all categories other than person crimes, we have exceeded the previous year. Some of these are, again, in relation to several people who have had multiple crimes attributed to them, throughout town.

Finally, looking at the Contract Cities Crime Report (**Exhibit B**, Page 5) at the end of the report, Harrisburg has ended the year ahead of all other cities for crime, in terms of the current year to date, compared to last year. Our numbers, 141 this year, exceeded those of last year at 120. Several people were responsible for multiple crimes, which throws off the numbers. We are the largest contract city, so it stands to reason that also with more hours than the other cities, that we have more crime YTD this year. This year's crime results are still two less than Millersburg had last year in 2024, but they have 38 less than Harrisburg does in this current year category.

Based on these results, Staff is glad that our recent financial forecast allows us to continue at the current coverages. We all share concern about the tragic conclusion to 2025, and Staff feels that it is especially important for us to maintain our current standards. LCSO takes these stats to heart, and we know that our law enforcement partners will be focusing on Harrisburg in 2026.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Bella Martinez-Ramos, the owner of Nuestro Sabor, recently moved her business from its location inside American Market to the Restaurant that previously held 36 Spices, Outfitters and the Vault. Under an arrangement with the prior owner, she has not previously had her own liquor license. This license will apply to both the restaurant and the bar.

This will allow her to provide Retail On-Premises Sales and Consumption; it is confirmed that it's only indoor consumption at this time, and that minors will only be allowed on the restaurant side of the business. As a reminder, only the OLCC can approve a liquor license; the City governing body only makes a recommendation to the OLCC for approval or denial. Bella has done a great job in promoting her business at this location, and is very dedicated to being a good business owner. She is working towards allowing event rental in one of her large rooms upstairs, but for now, she does offer people the ability to rent a portion of the restaurant if desired, just as the City did for the retirement party we held for Patsy VanLeeuwen

The OLCC does investigate each owner of a liquor license for a business location. If the business location has problems with OLCC, police or neighbors, or if the applicant has a criminal history, provided false information, and/or has a history of abusing drugs

or alcohol, the investigation may take longer, and could be denied. The motion making the recommendation to OLCC is at the top of the staff report.

## Local Government Recommendation – Liquor License

Per OAR 845-005-0304(3): The Commission requires an applicant for issuance of a new license issued under ORS chapter 471, to provide written notice of the application to the local government in the form of a complete, accurate, and legible Commission form.

The local government is as follows:

- (a) If the address of the premises proposed to be licensed is within a city's limits, the local government is the city.
- (b) If the address of the premises proposed to be licensed is not within a city's limits, the local government is the county.

### INSTRUCTIONS:

**Step 1:** Applicant completes all of Section 1 (including top of Page 2).

**Step 2:** Applicant submits both pages of the form to the appropriate local government. NOTE: The local government may require additional forms and/or fees.

**Step 3:** Local government completes at least Section 2 and returns all pages of the form, or a copy thereof, to the applicant. The local government is allowed up to 45 days to complete Section 3.

**Step 4:** Applicant takes the form with at least Sections 1 and 2 completed and includes it with their CAMP application to meet the Local Government Recommendation document requirement. Submissions that do not have at least Sections 1 and 2 completed will not be accepted.

**Step 5:** The local government issues its final recommendation in Section 3 and returns the completed form to the applicant. If the applicant has already submitted their initial application via CAMP, they hold on to the final recommendation and provide it to their investigator, when requested. If they have not already submitted their application, they upload the fully completed Local Government Recommendation form with their initial application submission.

**Applicants within the city of Portland ONLY:** After completing the attached form, please follow these steps to complete the Local Government Recommendation process:

- Apply via the [City of Portland website](#).
- Once you have completed the application with the City of Portland, you will receive an email notifying you that your application has been accepted, usually within two business days. The email will contain an attachment titled "ABC Public Notice."
- Upload the ABC Public Notice document with your CAMP application to meet the Local Government Recommendation document requirement.

NOTE: This document only provides proof of submission. Once you receive your final recommendation from the City of Portland, you will need to provide that to your assigned OLCC investigator.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

The Strategic Plan, Comprehensive Plan (with Buildable Land Needs Analysis), and Capital Improvement Plan, plus Master Plans, are the most important plans that the City has in place. These represent the actions that the City is taking, while meeting State of Oregon public engagement requirements. The City Council is asked to review the Strategic Plan on an annual basis, in order to make sure that goals remain in-line with our values as well as citizens’ expectations of the City.

The current Strategic Plan is based on a five-year rolling window, which is updated on an annual basis. The Strategic Plan process can take a considerable amount of time for staff to review and determine changes. The actions within the plan are reviewed by the City Administrator, and all Department Heads, which are the City’s highest paid personnel.

When we first put the Strategic Plan in place, Council was asked if they wanted to have a system like the one we are currently using, or if they wanted to have a true five-year plan. The choice was the current five-year rolling window plan. Because the City Administrator, and other staff, are being inundated with planning and environmental requirements that are mandatory for the City to have in place (Example: TMDL and FEMA/SFHA) it might be time for the City Council to consider whether a true five year plan should instead be the model that we currently use. A five-year plan would still be



reviewed on an annual basis, but only in terms of priorities. Otherwise, the current process of changing the plan would typically start at the end of the calendar year preceding the end of the current five-year plan.

Council and City Staff should discuss, and determine which version of planning works best for the City at this time. Staff can then review the changes that she has made to the current plan suggested in **Exhibit A**.

The Strategic Plan belongs to the City Council; this plan provides Staff with directions on where to direct City resources, especially the time and energy of all City Staff. Please review and determine if these objectives and actions are still in-line with your expectations. Council is also encouraged to suggest actions and objectives that they'd like City Staff to review. Please review and plan to update priorities for the next fiscal year at a future timeframe.

There are four overarching themes in the plan, which bring focus to the mission and vision of the city and organize the long-term goals of the plan. The four themes of the plan are:

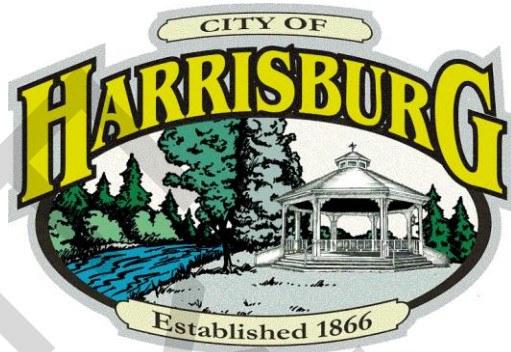
1. Great Neighborhoods

**Public Service** – We are public servants. We proactively find solutions to the community's needs. We are accessible, responsive, respectful, consistent, and understanding. We provide assistance beyond our customers' expectations.

**Fiscal Responsibility** – Proper use of public resources is a trust which we honor and protect. In our management of this trust, we must avoid even the appearance of impropriety. In our management of public funds, we constantly strive for the greatest possible efficiency and effectiveness.

**Personal Honesty and Integrity** – Each of us demonstrates the highest standards of personal integrity and honesty in our public activities to inspire confidence and trust in our government.

**Excellence** – Excellence is shown by being creative, professional, innovative, showing initiative, and being committed to our community. In this pursuit, we support continuing education and training for everyone in the organization.

**Teamwork** – We are a team that supports each other and the community, and we emphasize a high level of trust. We embrace a spirit of teamwork, empowerment, cooperation, collaboration, and community. We operate under the Together Everyone Accomplishes More (T.E.A.M.) concept.

**Diverse and Humane Organization** – We are an organization that has always honored diversity and protection of individual rights. Open communication, respect for others, compassion, and a sense of humor are essential tools in our organization. We value the cultural and social diversity that is reflected in our community, and we welcome the changes and new perspectives that this diversity brings to us.

## Strategic Plan Themes

The Strategic Plan has four main themes that reflect our Mission and Vision Statements: Great Neighborhoods, Public Safety, Economic Development, and Efficient Governance. Specific goals, objectives, and actions related to these four themes will allow the city to achieve its mission and follow the vision of the community.

Each theme includes the City's primary goals under that theme for the foreseeable future. The goals should remain constant over time and only be revised to reflect significant community changes or unanticipated events. A list of measurable objectives with benchmarks helps us track progress towards the goals. Objectives are generally identified to cover the five-year strategic planning period from the date they are adopted. Action items are the steps needed to meet the objective. Many more strategies and action items will be developed throughout the organization to align the entire organization with the goals and objectives identified in this plan.

This Plan is intended as a work in progress. While the mission, vision, values, and goals should remain constant, the objectives and action items will need periodic review and adjustment. We will track progress through regular reporting on the measures, and they will be incorporated into organization and community publications. The annual Budget and Capital Improvement Program will serve as reporting and implementing policy documents, that bear close relationships with the Strategic Plan. Those include the Comprehensive Plan, Transportation System Plan (in progress), Water Master Plan, Parks Master Plan, and in the future, the Wastewater Master Plan, and Storm Drainage Plan, plus related planning documents that also support the Strategic Plan.

The Plan, although adopted near the beginning of the calendar year, depends on the Fiscal Year for its annual progress or implementation. For example, a plan objective identified to be accomplished in 2022 means Fiscal Year 2022-23. (July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023) The timing of the adoption of the plan allows the City Council to have a mid-year check on how the prior year's plan objectives are progressing and assists City staff with preparing the budget to assist with the Council's priorities adopted in the Plan.
