CALL TO ORDER AND ROLL CALL

Chairperson K. Prozialeck called the meeting to order at 5:31pm.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

THE MATTER OF DISCUSSING LIBRARY PROGRAMS STAFF REPORT:

Book Club: K. Hansen stated there were 2 people who participated last month. November's meeting will be at Chopstix on November 15th.

Crafting Club: Prozialeck stated the club is going well and they like having it on the same day each week. Craft Club will be held every Thursday.

D & D: Finished campaign. They will restart next campaign after holidays.

Game Night: A. Pelkey suggested changing the time from 5pm-6pm on the 1st Thursday to 6:30pm-7:30pm due to conflict with school sport practices. A. Pelkey also suggested that they also hold a gam night on the 3rd Thursday for teens from 6:30pm-7:30pm.

Sewing Class: K. Prozialeck stated that several residents were interested in the program. They are still trying to set a start day and time.

Storytime: L. Pelkey commented the program is going well and they had a great turnout for Halloween.

October 03, 2022

Lego Club: A. Pelkey stated it was still a small group, but they were getting ready to send out flyers to schools. It is held every Saturday from 11am to noon.

Computer Class: Classes will start in December and be held every Wednesday from 6pm-7pm in the library.

Karaoke Club: Meeting the 1st Saturday of the month at 1pm. Hoping to grow this group. **Dance:** C. Spangler reported they had over 40 kids attend the Halloween dance. They only had issues with 3 kids who were asked to leave. They are looking for a bigger venue next year and are hoping to hold dances on a quarterly basis.

Spangler will haul the trailer that will have a ticket booth, greenery, big lights, and a big ticket. The Board will meet in the morning on the 3rd to assemble the float. K. Pelkey will purchase banners and A. Pelkey will get a refrigerator box for the ticket booth.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Programs currently available:

- Adult Book Club: Review the status of this program. It was discussed at the last meeting
 of possibly holding this event at a private resident's home and not having it continue as a
 Library Program
- Crafting Club: This program is held every Thursday from 5pm to 7pm at the Municipal Center. The program is instructed by Board Member, Kristi Prozialeck, and all ages are welcome to attend.
- Dungeons & Dragons (D & D): This program is held on the 1st and 3rd Wednesday of each month from 4pm to 6pm at the Municipal Center. Program volunteers are Quinton Sheridan and Sef Robin. Starting new campaign in January.
- Game Night: This is a newer program and will be Thursday, January 5th from 6:30pm to 7:30pm. Plenty of games available for all ages. Teen Game Night will be Thursday, January 19th from 6:30pm to 7:30pm.
- **Sewing Class**: This is a new program designed for teenagers. It will be held on Monday, January 2nd and January 16th from 4pm 6pm.
- **Story Time:** Story time is held every Friday, from 10am to 11am in the Municipal Center. The program is instructed by Board Member, Dez Hansen and Board Member, Lori Pelkey. Librarians Cheryl Spangler and Amanda Pelkey assist alternating Fridays. This program includes interaction between parent and child, story time, crafts, and a lot of fun!
- **Lego Club:** Lego Club is every Saturday from 11am to noon, in the Library, and is instructed by Librarian Amanda Pelkey. This program is designed to assist young children learn fine motor skills, develop problem solving techniques while having some fun on the way!
