### THE MATTER OF HOLDING AN ANNUAL HRA MEETING AS REQUIRED BY THE HRA BY-LAWS, ARTICLE III, SECTION 1.

**STAFF REPORT:** Hitt noted that we are required to have an annual meeting at this time every year to discuss the projects we have going. You can ask for details, or simply decide that there is nothing to discuss.

The Board discussed the HRA Grant Program Status as of December 30, 2020. The program has \$51,941 left for future loans.

- Downey stated that ICCO received funds. She asked if they were still making payments while they are closed.
- Nelson replied they are current on payments.
- Downey suggested we should reach out to them and find out their intentions. She also suggested adding a stipulation to future loans about how long they need to remain open after receiving funds.

The Board also discussed the HRA Maximum Indebtedness Status as of January 1, 2021. The original Maximum Indebtedness amount was \$8,177,674. The current balance is \$4,200,548.
