b. US23 / M59 Gateway Discussion

Manager Luce gave a brief overview of the M-59/US-23 interchange landscaping discussions and thanked Planning Commissioner Sue Grissim being here tonight to review her plans. He stated Commissioner Grissim has done a fantastic job putting together the design renderings and gave us many options to discussed. He stated he is looking for a determination as to how we will move forward on this project after tonight's discussion. Commissioner Grissim presented her initial big scale design plan stating she was trying to make an impactful, bold statement for the entire intersection that you would feel not only coming on and off the freeway, but as you traveled up and down on M-59, recognizing the speed of traffic in this area. She stated they worked with MDOT on this project and studied all of the rules to make sure their design met all of the MDOT criteria. She stated the location of the Welcome to Hartland signs was important and we were able to locate

them on the side slope of US-23 on both off ramps. She then presented a breakdown of the cost of each area to be able to to look at a phased in approach working within the landscaping budget for the project. Discussion was held on Commissioner Grissim's Phase One and Phase Two design specifications and cost estimates for each specific area, the positive cooperation we were getting from MDOT stating MDOT thought we had an 80% chance of our plan approved, including the planting of 8" diameter trees in each of the entrance/exit islands, and MDOT plan review timeframes. Further discussion was held on the painting of the brick walls under the bridge, and potential lighting under bridge, clearing the slope areas and the northeast area of the northbound entrance ramp to US-23, tree planting for Phase Two, timing of overall project, and long term maintenance requirements. A brief discussion was also held on the Township signs on the east and west side of the Township for potential upgrading. Consensus of the Board was to move forward with MDOT on the permitting process for the first two phases of the project plan we have, getting a cost for painting the brick walls under the bridge, and holding another work session to firm up the details. Manager Luce then gave an update on the current budget for this project.

#### c. Manager's Report

Manager Luce stated that Chick-Fil-A public hearing will be at the first PC meeting in April and should be at the Board in early May. He stated that Redwood Phase II Final PD is on a temporary hold due to developer personnel issues and that the Climate Control Storage building is in their Final PD stages. He stated the staff has been working with our LCSD Deputies, the State Police and the State Police Task Force on a marijuana complaint in the Township. This is not the Townships jurisdiction regarding the number of plants that you are allowed to have or grow for personal or medicinal purposes and was referred to the State Police. Manager Luce stated he had a very good meeting with the HERO Board regarding their search for a Executive Director. He also provided a brief update on the former tree cutting business regarding large burn piles that required the HDFA to put out one evening, and go back next morning to put out the fire again. He stated that this individual has still not complied with the judges decision in the court case with the Township. Manager Luce met with a Code Enforcement Officer that is a retired Police Sergeant that lives in the Township and he had some questions regarding our Code Enforcement Officer position. Manager Luce has referred him to Planning Director Troy Langer. Manager Luce stated he will be out of the office next week for the Michigan Township Associations Annual Conference in Grand Rapids. Manager Luce stated that Sheetz has asked for information on the permit application process but they have not submitted anything at this time. He also stated that the Kroger Gas Station has submitted a concept plan and the Site Plan Committee has reviewed it and we are waiting for a formal concept plan to be submitted to the PC.

On Monday, March 31 at 2:00pm, construction bids were opened and publicly read at the Hartland Township Hall for the Water Treatment Plant Improvements Phase 1 - Filter Rehabilitation Project. The project includes the removal and replacement of media material in two potable water filter tanks; and the removal, installation and rehabilitation of piping and valves at the Water Treatment Plant in Hartland Township.

The Township Clerk's office received two (2) sealed bids for this project. Two (2) bids were accepted. The apparent low bidder, Platinum Mechanical Inc., submitted a total base bid of \$633,088.00 for construction. Following the bid opening, Spalding DeDecker reviewed the bids, verified the calculations, and prepared the bid tabulation for the project (attached).

# **Hartland Water Filtration Plant**

#### 2025 Plant Upgrades - Phase 1 Project

#### **Objectives:**

- 1. Primary
  - a. Install necessary headworks piping and manual isolation valves to isolate filters for the media replacement.
  - b. Replace the media in the filters and restore to operation prior to the high summer flow season by the beginning of June.
  - c. Repair/replace Air Scour system blower as necessary to return to operational condition so that the backwash process returns to full scour/cleaning operation.
  - d. Repair/replace broken control butterfly valves on Filter 2 Finish (Effluent) water

# *Filter Isolation* - Breakdown of critical steps and coordination requirements to minimize WTP downtime:

- 1. <u>Step 1 Raw Header Bypass Tee and Valve One daytime shut down:</u>
  - a. Coordinate with Township staff to fill and top off the water tower in the overnight/early morning hours to maximize window for downtime. (Note: Alternately, an evening/overnight work window during low demand could be explored with the Township.)
  - b. Remove upper 16"x43 5/8"L spool piece fitting on the upper Raw Influent Header from the 90 deg bend of the riser in the SE corner of the Filter Room.
  - c. Install 16"x16" Tee, 16"x14" Reducer, 14" Butterfly Valve (with manual chain operator), temporary 14" blind flange (for sanitary protection) and 16"x 13.5"L (+/-) spool piece in place of the removed spool piece.
  - d. All parts will be swabbed in chlorine solution.
  - e. Return system to operation, both filters in service.
- 2. <u>Step 2 Filter 1 Effluent Isolation Valve One daytime shut down:</u>
  - a. Coordinate with Township staff to fill and top off the water tower in the overnight/early morning hours to maximize window for downtime. (Note: Alternately, an evening/overnight work window during low demand could be explored with the Township.)
  - b. Remove 10"x16"L spool piece fitting on the lower Filter 1 Finish Effluent tie in to the 16"x10" Tee on the Main Effluent header.
    Install 10" Plug Valve (with manual handwheel operator), and 10"x 3"L(+/-) spool piece/flange fillers in place of the removed spool piece.
  - c. All parts will be swabbed in chlorine solution.
  - d. Return system to operation, both filters in service.

- 3. <u>Step 3 Filter 2 Effluent Isolation Valve One daytime shut down:</u>
  - a. Coordinate with Township staff to fill and top off the water tower in the overnight/early morning hours to maximize window for downtime. (Note: Alternately, an evening/overnight work window during low demand could be explored with the Township.)
  - b. Remove 10"x16"L spool piece fitting on the lower Filter 2 Finish Effluent tie in to the 16"x10" Tee on the Main Effluent header.
  - c. Install 10" Plug Valve (with manual handwheel operator), and 10"x 3"L(+/-) spool piece/flange fillers in place of the removed spool piece.
  - d. Remove 14" Blind Flange on end of Main Effluent header.
  - e. Install 14" Butterfly Valve (with manual handwheel operator) and 14" Blind Flange.
  - f. All parts will be swabbed in chlorine solution.
  - g. Return system to operation, both filters in service.
- 4. <u>Step 4 Raw Header Blind Flange (Final Isolation of Filter 2)</u> One daytime shut down:
  - a. Coordinate with Township staff to fill and top off the water tower in the overnight/early morning hours to maximize window for downtime. (Note: Alternately, an evening/overnight work window during low demand could be explored with the Township.)
  - Remove upper 16"x14" Eccentric Reducer and the 14" Flange assemblies between the upstream twin 16"x6" Tees of Filter 1 and downstream twin 14"x6" tees on Filter 2.
  - c. Install 16" blind flange in place of the 16"x14" reducer on end of 16"x6" tee on Filter
    1.
  - d. Cover 14" end of 14"x6" tee on Filter 2 for sanitary protection.
  - e. All parts will be swabbed in chlorine solution.
  - f. Return system to operation, both filters in service.

**Note:** Steps 1 through 4 can be combined into simultaneous shutdowns to minimize disruption to operations; however, the blind flange noted in Step 4, must be the last step in the process. Once that is installed, Filter 2 cannot be placed into service until the upper header extension is completed.

# <u>Raw/Influent Header Extension and Filter Media Replacement</u> - Breakdown of critical steps and coordination requirements:

- 5. <u>Step 5 Raw/Influent Header Extension Filter 2 Offline work:</u>
  - a. Remove temporary 14" blind flange and extend 14" header to the new 14"x10" Tee to Filter 2 tie over, install 14"x12" Reducer, 12" Manual Butterfly Valve with Chain operator, and 12" Blind Flange. Install pipe support system.
  - b. Install 14"x10" Reducer, 10" Plug Valve (with manual chain operator) on exiting 14" Tee on the Filter 2 Influent header.
  - c. Install 10" Spool piece with flanged coupling adapter, 10" 90-degree bend and 10" spool piece with adjustable flange to 10" side connection of 14"x10" Tee on new Main header. Install pipe support system.

- 6. <u>Step 6 Replace Faulty Filter 2 Effluent Valves Filter 2 Offline work:</u>
  - Remove 8" Pratt/Meuller butterfly valve (CV-22) and 6" Pratt/Meuller butterfly valve (CV-23) on the Filter 2 effluent line and replace in kind. Reuse the existing pneumatic actuators.
  - b. Inspect the orifice flow control orifice upstream of the 6" valve (CV-23), clean and provide measurements and photographs of the orifice opening for evaluation and potential replacement during the Phase 2 Project.
- 7. <u>Step 7 Repair/Replace Faulty Air Blower Unit Filter 2 Offline work:</u>
  - a. Replace the air blower motor.
  - b. Complete this step while Filter 2 is offline so the system can be test run against Filter 2 in isolation but with the ability to test against water in the vessel.
- 8. <u>Step 8 Remove and Replace Filter 2 Media Filter 2 Offline work:</u>
  - Open exterior manway hatches on both Cells of the Filter 2. Document conditions of media and evidence of compromised integrity of internal components (ex: significantly uneven media, preferential pathways to underlying headers, or other obvious wear)
  - b. Protect/provide sanitary covering of manway access hatches during non-work time.
  - c. Remove existing Filter media down to the support gravel interface.
  - d. Inspect internal components for signs of damage or excessive wear.
  - e. Coordinate inspection with Owner and Engineer.
  - f. Report any damage or wear. Coordinate the necessary repairs or replacement.
  - g. Install replacement media bed material.
  - h. Replace manway gaskets.
  - i. Disinfection and pressure testing procedures for Filter 2 and headworks piping.
  - j. Open isolation valves and return Filter 2 to service.
  - k. Test operation of Filter 2 under system conditions including backwash and achieved rates.
- 9. <u>Step 9 Remove and Replace Filter 1 Media Filter 1 Offline work:</u>
  - a. Isolate Filter 1 with manual valves.
  - b. Open exterior manway hatches on both Cells of the Filter 1. Document conditions of media and evidence of compromised integrity of internal components (ex: significantly uneven media, preferential pathways to underlying headers, or other obvious wear)
  - c. Protect/provide sanitary covering of manway access hatches during non-work time.
  - d. Remove existing Filter media down to the support gravel interface.
  - e. Inspect internal components for signs of damage or excessive wear.
  - f. Coordinate inspection with Owner and Engineer.
  - g. Report any damage or wear. Coordinate the necessary repairs or replacement.

#### **Recommended Action**

Authorize the Public Works Director to act on behalf of the Township to facilitate the purchase and application of roadway chloride with the forthcoming contract from Chloride Solutions in an amount not to exceed \$111,100.

#### Discussion

Public Works is recommending the purchase of roadway chloride through Chloride Solutions, LLC in a cooperative purchase with the Livingston County Road Commission.

Chloride Solutions has provided their rate for 2025 and has provided satisfactory results for the past eight years. LCRC has used Chloride Solutions for the past eight years with success as well.

The approved budget allocation for road chloride for the 2025 season includes \$86,600 from the General Fund, and \$24,500 from the Road Millage Fund. This equates to a 75% / 25% split. The budget is based upon 4,000 gallons per mile, however lesser rates are applied if road moisture content is higher than expected. A cost savings has been recognized in the prior eight years based on a climate adjusted application rate.
