MOTION: Perlow/Axelrod – Moved to reduce the respondents fine to \$4,500.00 payable within 30 days of the date of the hearing or the fine shall revert to the original amount of \$8,500.00. Based upon a roll call, Vice Chairperson Perlow (Yes), Member Axelrod (Yes), Member Cherbini (Yes), Member Perilman (Yes), Member Lasorsa (Yes), and Chairperson Schlam (Yes). The motion passed 6 to 0.

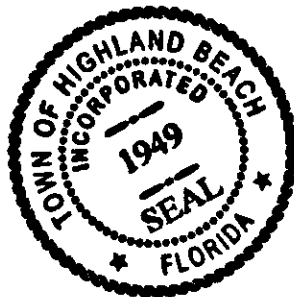

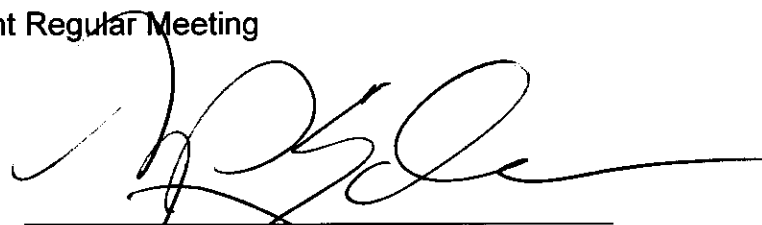
9. ADJOURNMENT
