

5. Updates

A. Invasive Removal Team



Member Tim Logue shared that the team finished planting seedlings and live stakes at Murray Street Park, Turnip Patch Park, Riverwalk, and Gold Park. He explained the bare root plants from Mellow Marsh were smaller than expected and we may need a different source next time. He shared that 15 volunteers showed up for the Creek Week workday and that the invasive species group will work every third Saturday instead of every third Wednesday through the spring.

B. Garden Club

Trueblood shared club events as submitted by Garden Club President Tammy Dorman.

C. Staff

Trueblood reported:

- The native plant policy for town properties will go to the Town Board for approval in April.
- Tree Board will host an invasive species removal workday during the Climate Challenge in April. Staff will also give a talk about ecological landscaping.
- Trueblood shared the 2024 Leave the Leaves campaign results.
- Trueblood reported that cemetery plantings are complete.
- April is Native Plant Month
