B. Kings Highway Park Master Plan:

The board members reviewed the Kings Highway Park master plan that was approved in 2016, noting improvements that had been made since the time of adoption. Board members discussed inviting Terry Hackett and Bryant Green to the next meeting to talk about stormwater and utilities in the park. Board members also discussed integrating the forest management plan into the master plan and noting significant cultural and historical resources. Board members suggested that future interpretive signage may include topics

such as the utilities operations in the park including the dam, dewatering basin, water intake and water treatment. Board members also suggested developing safety recommendations and adding information about flooding in the master plan.
