Staff will invite Terry Hackett to discuss the Eno River water quality requirements and stream buffers. In addition to utilities and regulations the plan will address topics including history, connectivity, economic impacts, transportation, return on investment, resilience, public health, culture and arts, events and tourism, the state parks and Mountains-to-Sea Trail, Occaneechi Village and the Great Indian Trading Path.
