Commissioner Robb English reported that the Town Board approved the FY27 budget without a tax rate increase. He also shared that the region is experiencing drought conditions, but no water restrictions have been put in effect yet.

Member Hooper Schultz shared that the Planning Board was considering a rezoning on Meadowlands Drive and text amendments to improve Historic District Commission processes.

C. Intergovernmental Parks Work Group

6. Park steward reports

Board members reported on the conditions of the parks for which they serve as stewards. Trueblood noted any small repairs that needed attention and gave brief reports on small repairs that had been made since the previous meeting.
