

The City of Homer has received two architectural plans from Stantec for the proposed new multi-purpose community center to be located on the current HERC site at Sterling Highway and Pioneer Avenue. Stantec provided the initial presentation to the Homer City Council at the February 28th regular meeting. 








HERC FACILITY · OPTION A & B - GROUND FLOOR PLAN
