Committee to Revise HCC 11.36 Vegetation in Public Rights-of-Way

View of Public Rights-of-Way



- Common misconception: The Public Right of Way (ROW) ends at the roadway edge.
- Public Utilities lie within the ROW and commonly outside of the Road Shoulder or Ditch

Right-of-Way Clearances



- 14-ft typical to accommodate large traffic and maintenance equipment
- Walkways can be 8-ft clearance or taller to accommodate maintenance equipment
- Note: In winter, branches droop or can be damaged and seasonally droop into clearance zone

- ► HCC 11.36.010 Vegetation in rights-of-way: Introductory section
 - Provides PWD some ability to conduct vegetation removal, however is vague and seems to limit PWD ability to manage needs.



- ► HCC 11.36.030 Annual Road Maintenance Plan: Section requires PWD to develop plan and submit to Council
 - ► This should be a stand alone section such as placing it as a new section 11.02 because it does not relate to Vegetation Clearing in ROW



- ► HCC 11.36.040 Public Notice: Section requires Public notification before work to be completed (30-day notice and 7-day notice)
 - ▶ 30-day Notice: 30 days are not always possible before work needs to commence
 - ▶ 7-day notice: Defines additional (duplicative) notification for mature tree's this is vague and left for interpretation to what is a "mature tree"

Notification process leaves no ability for PW to conduct required work when a member of the public protests work

- Use of term Adjacent versus Abutting
 - Adjacent is used in Code in the context of the definition of Abutting and this provides the ability for someone to object to clearing of a tree across the street from their property.

Examples of situations



- Example of vegetation that gets weighted with wet snow and leans over roadway into plowing equipment windows
- Also visible in next photo is 3-ft deep ditch for stormwater culvert hidden by growth.

Examples of Situations



- Looking down into ditch from previous photo
- Note: Water valve box (blue) on right side
- Note: green utility pedestal above storm pipe
- Note: Alder protruding out of back slope of ditch

Examples of Situations



- Tree is obstructing sight line for larger trucks and equipment
- Keep in mind, a grader's operator station is approximately 14-ft behind the front wheels

Example of Situations



- Note: alder and tree's growing in stormwater ditch obstructing flow path
- Note: alder are leaning into roadway
- Note: If this was a road intersection, impairment in sight lines

Examples of Situations



Large spruce tree at City Hall is preventing the replacement of a failed fire hydrant that requires replacement (not functional and not repairable)
