VILLAGE OF HOMEWOOD BOARD OF TRUSTEES MEETING TUESDAY, JANUARY 28, 2024 VILLAGE HALL BOARD ROOM

<u>CALL TO ORDER</u>: President Hofeld called the meeting of the Board of Trustees to order at 7 p.m.

PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: President Hofeld led trustees in the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL: Clerk Marilyn Thomas called the roll. Those present were Village President Richard Hofeld, Trustee Julie Willis, Trustee Vivian Harris-Jones, Trustee Jay Heiferman, Trustee Phillip Mason, Trustee Lauren Roman and Trustee Allisa Opyd.

President Hofeld introduced staff present: Village Manager Napoleon Haney, Village Attorney Chris Cummings, Fire Chief Bob Grabowski, Police Chief Denise McGrath, Director of Public Works Josh Burman, and Assistant Village Manager Terence Acquah.

<u>MINUTES</u>: The minutes of January 14, 2025, were presented. There were no comments or corrections.

A motion was made by Trustee Mason and seconded by Trustee Roman to approve the minutes as presented.

<u>Roll Call</u>: AYES --Trustees Willis, Harris-Jones, Heiferman, Mason, Roman and Opyd. NAYS - None.

<u>CLAIMS LIST</u>: The Claims List in the amount of \$1,175,309.95 was presented. There were no questions from the Trustees.

A motion was made by Trustee Willis and seconded by Trustee Harris-Jones to approve the Claims List as presented.

<u>Roll Call</u>: AYES --Trustees Willis, Harris-Jones, Heiferman, Mason, Roman and Opyd. NAYS - None. Motion carried.

President Hofeld said one item totaled nearly 80 percent of the Claims List: 2025 contribution to the Illinois Risk Management Agency -- \$931,189.00.

<u>OATHS OF OFFICE</u>: Clerk Thomas administered the oath of office to Kevin Coyle who accepted the position of Landscape and Maintenance Worker; Patrick DiDiana who accepted the position of Assistant Director of Public Works; and newly promoted Police Sergeant Michael Kozlowski.

HEAR FROM THE AUDIENCE: Resident Amy Crump addressed the board on what she said was disinformation spreading at all levels of society. She said denialism benefits those who create the lies. We all need to be aware of how propaganda can influence one's thinking. She pointed to a 1969 memo from the tobacco industry showing that manufacturers knew the harm cigarettes was causing, but the businesses used propaganda to create an alternate story. It was not until a 1991 civil suit that the propaganda was brought to light and the tobacco industry made cash settlements with people and government bodies.

Liz Varmecky of South Suburbs for Green Space said contaminants continue to flow into the pond at the Izaak Walton Preserve. She acknowledged the Village is trying to hire a consultant to determine how to remedy the problem, but it is taking a long time. She also asked how the Village would be impacted by President Trump's action freezing all federal grants. Manager Haney said the Village does not get much federal funding. It may impact the fire department's reimbursements from Medicaid for ambulance transportation.

<u>PRESENTATIONS:</u> Events Manager Marla Youngblood and Communications and Engagement Manager Antonia Steinmiller each gave a report on 2024 activities.

Manager Youngblood said the reception to the Village's 20 events has been outstanding. She was especially pleased to work with the Village of Flossmoor on the newest activity – a holiday trolley that drove people around to see holiday decorations in both communities. Events are drawing visitors to Homewood from the H-F area, as well as surrounding suburbs, Indiana and in some cases Michigan. This was the first year the Village ran the Art & Garden Show. It drew more than 100 vendors. In 2025, she is looking at joining with others to co-sponsor events, such as senior events hosted by the Homewood Library or the Homewood-Flossmoor Park District. (See report in board agenda.)

Manager Steinmiller told the Village Board that she and Assistant Village Manager Terence Acquah are working on developing an online application that will put information into the hands of anyone with a cell phone. It is just the latest effort she is working on to raise the profile of the Village and make Homewood news accessible to those in and outside the Homewood community. She outlined her efforts to increase online traffic to Homewood pages on Facebook, Instagram and other outlets. In 2024, the most popular Homewood story online was the Village's celebration of cicadas. A weekly Homewood Happenings email now has 5,100 views, and she helped with the roll-out of the new 911 app that is giving users immediate updates on emergencies. (See report in board agenda.)

President Hofeld asked for comments. Resident Chris Condon asked how to draw teens to Homewood events. Manager Steinmiller said that group is not following village news. She is going to try different approaches to draw them to the various social media sites. Liz Varmecky asked about public documents being available. Steinmiller told her on the Village's FOIA portal residents can search documents that have already been requested.

Trustees congratulated Steinmiller for her work, and said they are excited about the app. President Hofeld added that much credit goes to Manager Haney who spearheaded the new approach to sharing village information. Ms. Steinmiller received a round of applause from the audience.

<u>OMNIBUS VOTE:</u> The board was asked to pass, approve, authorize, accept, or award the following item(s):

- A. Reappointment/Firefighters' Pension Board/Christopher Cummings: Approve the reappointment of Christopher Cummings to the Firefighters' Pension Board for a three-year term ending on January 28, 2028.
- B. Reappointments/Veterans Committee/Charlene Dyer/Larry Garth: Approve the reappointments of Charlene Dyer and Larry Garth to the Veterans Committee for a three-year term ending on January 28, 2028.

- C. Annual Reports/Police Pension Fund Board/Firefighters Pension Fund Board: Accept the 2024 annual reports of the Police Pension Fund Board and the Firefighters Pension Fund Board.
- D. Agreement Amendment/Municipal Enforcement System/DACRA Tech LLC: Authorize the Village President to enter into an amendment to the master software licensing agreement with DACRA Tech LLC of Itasca, IL to incorporate DACRA Web-Pay Services.
- E. Agreement/Stray Animals/South Suburban Humane Society: Authorize the Village Manager to enter into a service agreement with South Suburban Humane Society of Matteson, IL for the temporary shelter of stray animals found within the Village.
- F. Agreements/Design Engineering and Construction Engineering Services/HR Green LLC: Authorize the Village President to enter into an agreement with HR Green of New Lenox, IL for design engineering services in an amount not to exceed \$38,445; and an agreement for construction engineering services in an amount not to exceed \$28,420; for a total cost not to exceed \$66,865 for repairs related to the 183rd Street railroad bridge.
- G. M-2336/Amendment to Fee Schedule/Fire Department: Pass an ordinance amending the "Fire" section of the fee schedule to allow the current fee to remain in place for the following calendar year in the event the annual calculated fee for the upcoming year is less than the current fee; and, remove certain fees for additional services.

Before the vote, Trustee Heiferman asked what the current expense was for South Suburban Humane Society. (Item E) Police Chief McGrath said it is about \$5,300 a year. Attorney Cummings, who is on the SSHA board, said fees cover only about 25% of the cost. He said SSHS has not raised fees in years. This three-year plan will help slowly increase SSHS funding without asking villages for an exorbitant amount at one time. Trustee Heiferman said he supports this contract extension.

Trustee Heiferman also asked about the damages by the truck crash at the 183rd Street viaduct. (Item F) Manager Haney said the trucking company was insured. The claim will go to IRMA for processing and collection.

A motion was made by Trustee Roman and seconded by Trustee Opyd to approve the Omnibus Agenda as presented.

<u>Roll Call</u>: AYES --Trustees Willis, Harris-Jones, Heiferman, Mason, Roman and Opyd. NAYS - None. Motion carried.

<u>GENERAL BOARD DISCUSSION</u>: Trustee Heiferman recognized Amy Crump as a charter member of the Homewood Science Center.

Trustee Opyd congratulated Managers Youngblood and Steinmiller for all their efforts in 2024.

She told a story of a new neighbor who found a dog in the yard as they were moving into the house. She was grateful for the relationship with South Suburban Human Society that took the dog in.

President Hofeld reminded residents that Dave's Hot Chicken is opening this week on Halsted Street. He encourages all to visit the new restaurant.

<u>ADJOURN:</u> A motion was made by Trustee Opyd and seconded by Trustee Mason to adjourn the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees.

Topic: Special Use – Multiple Family dwelling (7+ units), Mahmoud Essa, 18240 Harwood Avenue

PURPOSE

Mahmoud Essa is proposing to convert the existing building at 18240 Harwood Avenue into an apartment building. The subject property is a 16,646-square-foot building on a 0.82-acre site. The proposal is for fifteen (15) two-bedroom residential units. Previously, the building was occupied by Spornette International Inc. as a warehouse and production space. Under the new zoning ordinance (adopted in 2023), the light industrial use is no longer permitted in the B-2 Downtown Transition zoning district. The proposed residential use will occupy the entire structure.

A multiple family dwelling with seven (7) or more units is classified as a special use in the B-2 (Downtown Transition) zoning district. A special use permit is required for uses that have a unique character that must be individually evaluated for potential impact on adjacent properties and the perceived public need for the use at a specific location.

PROCESS

The applicant proposes to renovate the existing building into a multi-family residential use with eighteen (18) two-bedroom market-rate apartments. The project includes interior reconstruction to support residential use. The applicant intends to repair and preserve existing features of the building. Each apartment will have washer/dryer and HVAC in-unit. The basement will be used for storage for each apartment. Proposed parking spaces are twenty-seven (27) which meets the zoning requirement. The applicant proposes parking spaces assigned to the residential units. Required bicycle parking will be provided in the interior and exterior of the building.

Building residents will have 24-hour residential access at the front and side entrances through secured fob or code access. The plan is to keep the brick on the façade and add windows on the sides for each apartment unit.

The Staff Site Plan Review Committee reviewed the site plan on October 29, 2024, and requested changes to the plan. The applicant made the requested revisions and provided an updated site plan.



At its regular meeting on December 12, 2024, the Homewood Planning and Zoning Commission reviewed the requests for site plan approval and special use permit. The Planning and Zoning Commission voted unanimously to recommend approval of the special use permit, but tabled the site plan review to a future meeting. Commissioners requested additional information from the applicant and changes to the plans that included ADA compliance, emergency exits, minimum size of the units and bedrooms, landscaping, noise mitigation, and rental market projections.

On January 23, 2025, at a public hearing with the Planning and Zoning Commission, the applicant presented a revised site plan and response to the Commissioners' questions. Revisions to the floor plan and site plan included:

- 1. provided interior improvements with ADA-compliant access;
- 2. added third egress as emergency exit (locked, egress only);
- reconfigured the main floor regarding the units' square footage size to 15 units (vs. 18 units originally proposed); increased unit size to 888 sq. ft.; all units are now 2 bedroom (vs. one-bedrooms originally proposed); and increased bedroom sizes (smallest bedroom is 108 square feet);
- 4. added storage rooms along the southern hallway;
- 5. provided ADA lift near the southern entrance;
- 6. revised landscaping palate to meet Village requirements; and
- 7. added exterior bicycle parking.

The Planning and Zoning Commission approved the site plan by a vote of 5 to 1 (five ayes to one nay), with the condition that the applicant provide a structural report for Village staff review and approval prior to issuance of a building permit.

The Commission member who voted against the site plan felt that there was a mismatch between the unit design and the targeted market of "young professionals." Commissioners in support of the proposal felt that the units' size and the design of the warehouse conversion to apartments was creative and would attract a younger demographic.

OUTCOME

After consideration of public testimony, the following Findings of Fact (as proposed or amended) by the standards set forth in Section 2.16 may be entered into the record:

- 1. The subject property is a 0.82-acre site comprised of three parcels;
- 2. The project is located at 18240 Harwood Avenue, near the northwest corner of Harwood Avenue and 183rd Street;
- 3. The subject property is owned by Nour Esbahya;
- 4. The subject property is located within the B-2 Downtown Transition zoning district;



- 5. The proposed use is a multiple-family dwelling (7+ units) and requires a special use permit in the B-2 Downtown Transition zone;
- 6. The subject property was formerly used for light industrial. Light manufacturing uses and warehousing are currently not permitted in the B-2 Downtown Transition zoning district;
- 7. The proposed multiple-family residence use meets all applicable standards in the proposed zoning district (B-2 Downtown Transition);
- 8. The proposed residential use will operate within an existing building that is adequately served by utilities, access, and on-site parking; and
- The proposed development is to be constructed in general conformity with the following plans: Multi-Dwelling Unit Build-Out plans, dated 01/08/2025 prepared by Lucid Engineering Services.

ORDINANCE NO. M - 2337

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING A SPECIAL USE PERMIT TO ALLOW CONSTRUCTION OF A FIFTEEN UNIT MULTIPLE-FAMILY DWELLING AT 18240 HARWOOD AVENUE IN HOMEWOOD, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS.

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-13-1 *et seq.* authorizes municipalities under 500,000 population to determine and vary the application of their zoning regulations relating to the use of land; and

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-13-1.1 authorizes the granting of a special use by passage of an Ordinance in districts where such a permit is required; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received for a special use permit to convert the existing commercial building at 18240 Harwood Avenue to a 15-unit multiplefamily dwelling; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is located in the B-2, Downtown Transition zoning district; and

WHEREAS, multiple-family dwellings (greater than seven units) are allowed as a special use in the B-2 zoning district; and

WHEREAS, the Homewood Planning and Zoning Commission reviewed and considered the request at its regular meeting on December 12, 2024, and continued to January 23, 2025, and recommended approval of a special use permit to allow the operation of a multiple-family dwelling (7+ units); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois deem it appropriate and are willing to grant a special use permit, subject to the terms and provisions hereof.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Homewood, Cook County, Illinois, that:

SECTION ONE - FINDINGS OF FACT:

- 1. The subject property is a 0.82-acre site comprised of three tax parcels;
- 2. The project is located at 18240 Harwood Avenue, near the northwest corner of Harwood Avenue and 183rd Street;

- 3. The subject property is owned by 18240 Harwood Ave LLC, an Illinois limited liability company managed by Nour Esbahya and Rana A. Bawadi;
- 4. The subject property is located within the B-2 Downtown Transition zoning district;
- 5. The proposed use is a multiple-family dwelling consisting of fifteen (15) two bedroom units and requires a special use permit in the B-2 Downtown Transition zone;
- 6. The subject property was formerly used for light industrial. Light manufacturing uses and warehousing are not permitted in the B-2 Downtown Transition zoning district;
- 7. The proposed multiple-family residence use meets all applicable standards in the proposed zoning district (B-2 Downtown Transition);

Topic: Purchase Approval / Truck Replacement/ Ford F-550 Chassis (Dump Truck)

PURPOSE

Staff is requesting the Board approve the purchase of one (1) Ford F-550 Chassis from Homewood Ford for a total purchase not to exceed \$90,000. This will replace a 2010 Ford F-450 Dump Truck used by the Public Works Landscape Maintenance Division. The purchase will be financed through the five-year lease agreement that was approved by the Board of Trustees at the October 8, 2024 meeting.

PROCESS

Periodically, the Village of Homewood must replace equipment that has reached its end of life. Staff evaluates equipment on an annual basis and compiles a list of items that are recommended for replacement based off the American Public Works Association (APWA) Fleet Management recommendation. Below is the Public Works pickup truck that is due for replacement.

Truck #60: 2010 Ford F-450 w/ 49,300 Miles [15yr Old Dump Truck]

Through the budget process, approval was given to finance a plow truck utilizing a five-year lease. The annual lease payment is budgeted in the General Fund. Since the plow truck was not readily available, staff identified six (6) other vehicles for replacement. These vehicles were presented to the Board during the Village Board meeting on October 8, 2024, when the 2024 leasing program was approved. Truck #60 was identified to be replaced and financed.

Purchase Options

Staff researched purchase options and found vehicles to be available through a few avenues.

- Suburban Purchasing Cooperative Sutton Ford of Matteson, IL (2025) \$54,500
- Currie Motors of Frankfort, IL (2024) \$56,403
- Homewood Ford of Homewood, IL (2025) \$56,000



Suburban Purchasing Cooperative

A 2025 Ford F-550 can be ordered through the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative for a price of \$54,500. The delivery timeline is currently uncertain, but Public Works estimates it could arrive by mid-summer or early fall.

Currie Motors

A 2024 Ford F-550 is available now with Currie Motors of Frankfort, IL for \$1,903 more than the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative.

Homewood Ford

Homewood Ford has been working with public works staff to find solutions for some of our fleet replacements. A 2025 Ford F-550 can be ordered by Homewood Ford for \$1,500 more than the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative price; however, the benefit of keeping the Village's dollars local outweighs the small increased cost. As with the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative, the lead time for delivery is unknown by Public Works at this time but may be mid-summer or early fall.

Shop Local

Based on the prices provided for the purchase of a Ford F-550 chassis, the lowest quote was received from the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative at \$54,500. However, staff recognizes the importance of supporting local businesses whenever possible and would consider purchasing from a local vendor if the price is within \$2,000 of the lowest bid.

Vehicle leasing has been identified as a planned expense in the Village's five-year capital plan. It is essential for the Village to take every opportunity to support its Sales Tax Fund, as sales tax is the Village's largest source of revenue. Purchasing locally helps ensure that these funds are reinvested back into the community.

Accessories

Lighting, accessories, and equipment will need to be installed after the purchase from any of the three (3) vendors but will remain within the budgeted amount.





OUTCOME

The approval of this vehicle purchase will allow Public Works to replace an important asset to the fleet.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

- Funding Source: Five-Year Lease Agreement through BMO Harris Bank
- Budgeted Amount: \$80,000 in General Fund annual lease payment covering the purchase of six (6) Public Works vehicles/equipment
- Cost: \$90,000 to be financed over a five-year period through a lease agreement

Approve the purchase of one (1) Ford F-550 Chassis from Homewood Ford; and, approve the purchase and installation of lighting, accessories, and equipment (dump truck body) in a total amount not to exceed \$90,000.
