## 1. Planning Commission- Fiscal Impact Study Analysis

Discussion between Attorney and City Council regarding the best way to get the study.

Getting a bid for the study is the next step.

Sheri suggested they get 1 city council, 1 planning commission, and 2 community members to choose the company they use for the Fiscal Impact Study.

Discussion between the attorney and city council decided to contact the cities to see how their recent Smith's Marketplace affected their cities.

A list of bullet points needs to be given to the companies doing the study.

The city council needs to provide a list by Monday to Malcolm.

Malcolm will eliminate the duplicates and provide a list to City Council by Tuesday.

The City Council will send out the list to companies.

Bids will be brought to the next City Council meeting.

Sheri presented North Ogden and West Point Smith's Sheriff Analysis.

City Council will meet 30 minutes before the City Council Meeting on September 12 2024 to discuss the bids for the Fiscal Impact Study Analysis.

## 2. Senior Lunch

Mayor Sheri explained that Roy did away with Senior funding.

Sheri also explained that Roy might end up closing the Roy Center. The Roy Mayor is looking for funds yearly from West Haven and Hooper for their Roy Center. Sheri presented that Chris Morris and Blair Cottle have agreed to get donations to do meals for seniors. Meals for seniors could be twice a month, the first and the third Thursday of every month.

Mayor Sheri explained how many of Hooper's Senior went to other various cities senior lunches and activities.

The City Council and Mayor discussed the concern that could arise with other cities wanting funds.
