In the absence of a quorum, the meeting proceeded with general information and updates from Parks and Recreation Director, Brandon Artz. Key updates include the HAWC Task Force identifying five potential sites for the Regional Health, Aquatics, and Wellness Center, with cost estimates forthcoming, along with discussions on the future of the existing pool. A Forestry Grant with Arbor Pro will support tree assessments and new plantings, including along Main Street. Concerns about vandalism at Harrison Park were addressed. Additionally, construction of a new shelter at the food pod is underway, and the pickleball courts are nearing completion. Upcoming community events feature youth basketball, adult volleyball, and a Daddy-Daughter Dance in March.
