## Financial Report

The financial report for May 31, 2026 was reviewed. In addition staff presented a financial review of the Airport expenses and revenue from 2020 through 2026.

## Managers' Report

1. Tracy May from Precision Approach Engineering discussed FAA requirements and other issues involved in the potential construction of an alternate unpaved landing area at the Airport. Tracy reported that currently the FAA does not have a viable process to review and/or approve these landing areas. The Board requested that staff inquire with AOPA and EAA whether there were any efforts being made by those organizations with the FAA over the issue of alternate landing areas.
2. Staff reported on the fuel sales for June 2026.
3. Staff reported that during the next fiscal year the Airport aircraft fueling equipment will need new fuel hoses and replacement of the Avgas and Jet fuel filters.
4. Staff discussed new aviation companies that will be operating from the Airport this summer.
5. Staff reported that the fence between the Platt and City hangars is complete
6. The Board toured the Airport facility that Life Flight had been using and discussed potential new uses.
