Managers’ Report

1. Staff presented the Memorandum from the FAA dated July 31, 2026 showing the 5-Year Projects and Planned Funding between the City Airport and the FAA. In 2027 the plan is to replace the PAPI lights at the end of each runway. The large project scheduled for the future is the rehabilitation of the runway in 2030.
2. Fuel sales for the month of July were reviewed.
3. Staff reported that it had talked with Precision Approach Engineering so this Board can be made aware if in the future the FAA develops a viable approval procedure for construction of an alternate unpaved landing area that an airport to develop. Staff also reported that after conversations with AOPA and the EAA neither organization has a committee working with the FAA to establish that construction procedure.
