EOTEC ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Section 2, ItemA.

Present were committee members Luke Swanson, Doug Bennett, Mike Kay, and Patrick Collins. Also present were City Manager Byron Smith, EOTEC General Manager Al Davis, Councilman Doug Primmer & City staff Holly Lambert.

Committee member Weston Putnam excused. Committee members Jessica Narain, Jennifer Roberts and Youth Advisor Hailey Gardner absent.

Patrick opened the meeting at 5:30pm.

March 2nd, 2023, Minutes

Doug moved and Luke seconded to approve the March 2nd, 2023, EOTEC Advisory Committee regular meeting minutes as presented. **Motion passed unanimously.**

Barns Expansion Report

Byron shared the concern from the building official regarding defining the barn as a barn or a meeting of assembly and the potential need for a sprinkler system. The city is doing further research on the matter for the next meeting with the building official in two weeks. The city is also researching suppliers for barn materials.

Report on Field Expansion Project - HEROS

Luke reported on the field work in progress. Two more weeks of watering using land lines moved by hand are needed and then the field will need to be fertilized. With the groundwork in, grass growing and soon to be fertilized, the first phase of field development is wrapping up. Once the hand watering lines are removed, Phase Two will begin. Shelco Electric will begin work to run main electrical lines for lighting and the committee will build a structure to house electric and storage needs. The HEROS committee is hopeful to schedule a first tournament in July if the turf is ready. If not, many groups are looking to book tournaments this fall and in the future.

EOTEC Operations Update Report

Al reviewed the handout detailing year to date and upcoming events at the facility, current operational maintenance and first quarter revenue generated (see attached). Al shared they are updating the website, linking it to the city website and updating the calendar. They are looking at using software similar to the Parks and Recreation software for booking events and stalls for barrel racing and rodeo events.

Branding Update

Byron reported the process is not yet begun but coming soon.

Strategic Plan Review

Byron reviewed the strategic plan priorities list created in 2019 from the strategic plan and noted the items in progress or completed. The committee had no further questions.

Other Business

Councilman Primmer questioned the EOTEC facility's non-smoking designation. After clarification that all buildings on the EOTEC grounds are non-smoking, Doug requested outside smoking areas be clearly designated with signage.
