#### **HENDERSONVILLE TREE BOARD CALENDAR 2023**

Sunday, August 20 – Guided Tree Walk on Hendersonville's Main Street. 2 p.m. City Arborist Bill Leatherwood will lead a walk along Main Street to discuss how the various types of trees and shrubs are maintained and supported to a create stress-free environment for healthy plants. Open to the public at no charge. Limited to 25 people. Deadline to register is Aug. 17.

Sept. 1-4 – NC Apple Festival

Saturday, Sept. 30 – Flock to the Rock at Chimney Rock Park. 10 a.m. – 3 p.m. The City has been invited to host a Bee City USA tent or table at this event. The event, now in its 15<sup>th</sup> year, focuses on birding, but also includes discussion of Monarch migration and other pollinator information, as CRP is

an official monarch waystation. The Symbolic Monarch Migration, which will be going on in Henderson County schools during this same time period, can also be promoted. Volunteer Patrice German is going and has asked for other volunteers to help her out at the Hendersonville Bee City USA table.
