1. Call to Order

Meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. by Chair Beth Stang. Members present were Caroline Gunther, Chair; Neil Brown; Kim Bailey; Gray Jernigan; Roger Bass; Geri Conley; and Councilwoman Lyndsey Simpson

2. Adoption of Meeting Minutes

The meeting Minutes of the December 17, 2020 were adopted.

3. Discussion of Committees and Membership

Chairman Beth Stang advised when committees are formed the chairman will report back to the ESB. Chairman Stang also reported conversations with the City Clerk who clarified 1/3 of the membership may roll off of the board at a time and that City Council appoints membership to the ESB. Kim Bailey suggested a press release for both Bee City and ESB membership.

4. Discussion Recycling Committee and Mountain True

Chairman Beth Stang advised the recycling committee will be a part of Mountain True's Rectifying team w/Christine. Board members discussed the survey with the following findings:

- 13 businesses responded (2 restaurants and 11 gifts shops)
- ESB to work w/EAC and Christine.
- Cost was the biggest barrier.
- Shine uses all compostable and Dogwood is plastic free.
- Work w/city for resolution acknowledging it as a city venture.
- Some members will attend the City council meeting on 1/27/21.

5. Bee City

Mike Huffman discussed fundraising for Bee City and stating \$2,000 and \$200 were needed for renewal fee at the end of February. Mr. Huffman stated some of the funding will be used for plastic reduction decals and possibly an informational recycling magnet to present to Citizens at Sustainability Day at the Farmers Market for education.

Kim Baily will be upgrading a species list for bees and will give further feedback at the March Meeting

6. Sustainability Plan

ESB Board Members would like to help w/a sustainability plan for the City, perhaps in phases. Neil Brown encouraged creating a plan to span 20 years.

7. Other Discussion

Councilwoman Lyndsey Simpson will assist with literature and logos for ESB. Board members agreed to meet remotely through May 2021.
