Proposal for updates on 317 and 319 7th Avenue E

We currently have used all 7th Avenue facade grant funds, however since we can make a budget adjustment.

These buildings will also receive a credit for new awnings as a part of the 7th Avenue Streetscape (quote for awning replacement included).

The Community Character Team voted to recommend the Downtown Advisory Board request a budget amendment of \$5000 from the 7th Avenue Fund Balance to support this Façade Grant.

Dennis Dunlap was present at the meeting and Lyle Chariff (property owner) was present virtually to present the project. The project will remove the white paint, point and seal and provide a new store front for 317 and 319.

The committee requested additional cost breakdown for facade grant.

Matthew Hickman made a motion to recommend to approve the facade grant pending more detailed price quote. Patsy DuPre seconded, Caroline Gunther, Linda DiPaola, Matthew Hickman and Patsy DuPre were all in favor.
