SUGGESTED MOTION(S):

I move City Council approve city staff's plan to apply for the North Carolina Recreational Trails Program.

SUMMARY:

The Recreational Trails Program is a Federally Administered grant program, managed by the Federal Highway Administration, administered by the North Carolina Division of Parks & Recreation that aims to provide funding for the creation, renovation, and or acquisition of greenway and trails. City Staff has identified our greenway network as a pivotal resource for recreation for our community, and are striving to make improvements to our current Oklawaha Greenway trail. City staff is seeking approval to apply for grant funds that would develop a new Oklawaha Greenway Trailhead at the northern end of the trail as well as conduct design and installation of new trail signage and local park directional signage along the greenway.

BUDGET IMPACT: Grant Maximum award amount is \$100K.
We will be required to agree to a 25% match.
Budget impact should be about \$25K.
