#### 5. OLD BUSINESS

1. Friday Main Street Car Shows- Event Review

Lewis with the Apple Country Corvette Club spoke regarding the car show. The corvette club has been a part of the Music on Main event, in the past, they alternated weeks with the Carolina Mountain Classic Car Club. The classic car club is planning to be a part of each Music on Main show, and the corvette club would like to participate by extending to the court house. This was discussed at the April meeting but there was not a representative of the Corvette Club to speak and they were asked to come to the May meeting.

Corvette Club is proposing that if there is not a significant number of vehicles they will reopen the block for additional parking and traffic flow. The club also proposes reducing their closure to every other week.

Concerns from the board include access for customer parking.

Joe Dinan Motion for to recommend the Corvette Club application to extend the closure to 2nd Avenue, leaving avenues open every other week. This includes June 10, 24, July 22, August 5, 19. Meredith Friedheim gave an update on downtown events coming downtown. A list was included for street closures of events that are coming.

New events: Jump Off Rock half marathon, May 22 175th Birthday on Courthouse Block, July 4 is an extended closure 2 blocks north, this is an event in partnership with the TDA and Henderson County Parks and Recreation.

## 2. Downtown Team Field Trip & Grant Project Review

Board and staff members took a trip to Greenville and Travelers Rest, South Carolina to review special projects and initiatives. Jamie Carpenter, Lew Holloway, Caroline Gunther, Jerry Fitzgerald, Patsy DuPre and Michael Arrowood (HCTDA) attended several of the meetings and tours. Including: RingoFire/Campfire Greenville, Unity Park, Synergy Mill Makerspace, and the City of Travelers Rest. The team got ideas regarding connections and planning for the Ecusta Trail as well as future space needs an opportunities that may be valuable for downtown. Ringo Fire currently works with the City of Hendersonville for the recruitment initiative and is interested in opening their second location of their local business marketing resource "Campfire" in Hendersonville.

Currently, the noise ordinance (Sec. 20-33. - Noises prohibited, nuisances) includes the following section that is not being enforced. Staff recommends that instead of removing the ordinance in its entirety that hours are added (highlighted). This should have minimal impact on current operations while providing the ability to enforce late night nuisance as we encourage downtown residential living.

9)Any business situated within the municipal services district that permits to be played within its building any electronically amplified music or speech, regardless of whether such music is live, shall not permit any door from any street or alley into such building to be or remain open during such amplification except while persons or goods are actively entering or exiting the building through such door, nor shall it permit any window to be or remain open during such amplification during the hours of 12AM to 11AM.

#### **SUMMARY:**

In light of concerns with the execution of the second phase of sidewalk murals, the community character team recommends a contract with future applicants, similar to what is used for Façade and Pivot Grants.

This will include specific details that were agreed upon by appropriate committees, board, and staff. Staff will create an application form for future projects that includes project specific details to streamline process.

#### **Process:**

- 1. Interested party submits form with project scope, requests for downtown board and staff, and if there is a financial request the project should include a complete budget. Application must be submitted at least 90 days before project starts. Exceptions can be made but will not be guaranteed.
- 2. Application presented to appropriate subcommittee (most likely Community Character)
- 3. Application specifics updated by staff after feedback
- 4. Review by Downtown Advisory board and recommendation and submit to city council (depending on project)
- 5. Create signed agreement between applicant and signed by Downtown Manager and applicant that includes a requirements designated by staff and board members.
