CONVENED: 5:00 P.M.

WORKSHOP:

2022-2023 BUDGET WORKSHOP.

Mayor Miller said the City Council received a copy of the proposed 2022-2023 Operating Budgets on May 5, 2022. City Councilmembers should have had time to carefully review the budget proposals for

each department and all utilities.

The proposed General Fund expenditures have been increased by 6.85% from last year's budget. Expenditures in utility funds have been decreased or increased as follows: Water 29.92% decrease, Sewer - 2.01% decrease, Electric 55.60% decrease, Irrigation 315.89% increase, and Storm Water 14.32% increase.

There are no proposed utility fund transfers to the General Fund in this year's budget.

The City Council reviewed each department and its proposed budget.

The City Council asked if next year's budget could in a page on rental fees for baseball diamonds, soccer fields, etc.
