Engineer Update – Carl from Bolton and Menk is in attendance. The tie downs aren't draining, contractor will be back to fix them. The lighting was delayed by the weather in other places. Voltmer is hoping to be here in Sept. They have everything they need to get started. The SWIP was added for the new pavement in addition to ours being outdated.

Chairman/City Manager Update – Matt not in attendance. Dan's concern was the electrical that Carl addressed.

Airport Manager Update- Brett's report was accepted.

FBO Update – Dylan's report was accepted. Dylan introduced Taylor Thul who will be taking over when Dylan leaves Sept/Oct timeframe. P & N are still working on the Military Program, not sure where they are with it or what their overall promotion/advertising will look like.

Revenues and expenses to date – Everything looks good. Ended up with approximately \$20,000 remaining for the last fiscal year.

Additional Comments- Jones went to a presentation given by Mike Jones that he distributed to other members about how to run an effective airport. We are on track on a lot of these ideas.

Also, mud jacking was discussed – not eligible for grants, but can be looked into at a later date if needed. We are back to saving our entitlement funds. City currently does not have funding for much, but we can save up to \$600,000 (4 years worth). The lighting project used entitlement funds and that was charged to FY24.

- The airport has had a few leases turnover in the T-hangers in the past few months. I have decided that if time allows before someone moves into the hangar, I need to wash the walls and the floor. Some of these hangers have a lot of dust and cobwebs that need to be addressed. I have been able to clean 6 T-hangers due to people moving out or people having their planes serviced and their hangar is pretty much empty. This has been a great improvement to the hangers. We do not have any hangers open for rent currently.
- We had a Gulfstream come in with some business people going to a neighboring town to conduct business.
- The Independence Fire Department came out for a tour of the airport to discuss safety items, and how we would handle things.

Testing Center:

- The testing centers availably is still Monday through Wednesday, 8AM to 4PM.
- We had five testers and two I9 appointments this month.

Training:

- This month we had 70 hours of Flight Instruction, 4 hours of Pilot Aircraft rentals, 1 hours of air tours, and 3 hours of student solo time. That's a total of 78 hours of flight time, a 1,038% increase from last August.
- We Had two more First solos this month Myka, and Katelyn
- Dylans last day was last Friday 8/30/24. Taylor Thul is full time instructor while Malcolm Cleope and Tim Maroney are still instructing part time.

Maintenance:

- We are still offering a 15% discount to first-time maintenance customers.
- We have received P&N and third-party transit traffic from Marion, for maintaince work.
