ITEM TITLE: Jackson Green 7th Addition – Rezoning application

BACKGROUND:

Ron and Janice Ohl have applied to rezone a parcel of land they currently own from A-1, Agricultural to R-2, Mixed residential district in preparation for a one- and two-family residential housing development.

DISCUSSION:

The Planning and Zoning Commission should discuss the impact of removing this parcel from agricultural use and weigh the benefits verse any negative impacts produced due to rezoning to residential use.
