7. Discussion Items

- A. Department of Administration Services is requesting a supplemental allocation in the amount of \$826,500.00. This increases the total allocation to \$858,178.00. On August 10, 2020, a storm caused damages to Capitol Complex. Request is to cover repair costs.

The total allocation of \$858,178.00 exceeds the \$500,000.00 maximum threshold for 29C.20 claims set by the Executive Council's 1979 Guidelines for Allocation 29C.20 funds. The State Auditor's Office has reviewed request and recommends allocation, subject to audit of actual invoices.
