3. Leases

A. Lease between DNR and American River Transport Company, LLC

Date of Lease: Date of Consent to February 28, 2026

Legal Description: A parcel of the bed of the Mississippi River including approximately 1,600 feet of frontage by 210 feet of depth located at Mississippi River Mile 476.50 located in Section 5, Township 88 North, Range 3 East of the 5th P.M., Dubuque County, Iowa.

Purpose: Commercial

Annual Fee: \$13,067.51

4. Emergency Allocations

A. Department of Natural Resources is requesting an emergency allocation in the amount of \$12,739.51. On March 15, 2019, a flood caused damages at Wapsipinicon State Park in Jones County. Request is to cover repair costs not covered by FEMA.

The State Auditor's Office has reviewed request and recommends allocation, subject to audit of actual invoices.

B. Department of Natural Resources is requesting an emergency allocation in the amount of \$25,822.95. On May 30, 2019, flooding caused damages at Odessa Wildlife Management Area in Louisa County. Request is to cover repair cost not covered by FEMA.

The State Auditor's Office has reviewed request and recommends allocation, subject to audit of actual invoices.

C. Department of Natural Resources is requesting an emergency allocation in the amount of \$153,161.11. On May 21, 2019, flooding caused damages at Green Island Wildlife Area in Jackson County and Princeton Wildlife Area in Scott County. Request is to cover repair costs not covered by FEMA.

The State Auditor's Office has reviewed request and recommends allocation, subject to audit of actual invoices.

- D. Iowa Communications Network is requesting an emergency allocation in the amount of \$13,908.72. On June 23, 2021, ICN sustained cable damage due to cable exposure along US Highway 169 at Deer Creek in Webster County. Request is to cover repair costs.

The State Auditor’s Office has reviewed this request and recommends allocation, subject to audit of actual invoices and supporting documentation and demonstration that no costs covered by the maintenance contract have been included.

- E. Board of Regents – University of Iowa is requesting a supplemental emergency allocation in the amount of \$24,935.00. This brings the total allocation to \$71,323.58. On August 9, 2018 there was an electrical fire at the Iowa Advanced Technology Laboratory. Request is to cover repair costs.

The State Auditor’s Office has reviewed this request and recommends allocation and payment of the supplemental request. This represents full and final payment and this allocation will be closed.

- F. Board of Regents – Iowa State University is an emergency allocation and payment in the amount of \$37,518.72. On February 18, 2021, a sprinkler main burst due to low temperatures. Request is to cover repair costs.

The State Auditor’s Office has reviewed this request and recommends allocation and payment. This represents full and final payment and this allocation will be closed.
