The Executive Council met in regular session at 10:00 a.m. via conference call. Governor Kim Reynolds presided over the meeting. Secretary of State Paul Pate, Auditor of State Rob Sand, Treasurer of State Roby Smith, and Secretary of Agriculture Mike Naig were present.

- C. Department of Public Safety requested an emergency allocation in the amount of \$26,166.00. On March 31, 2023, storms caused broken radomes at the Iowa and Woodward ISICS Communication Towers. Request was to cover repair costs.
- D. Board of Regents University of Iowa requested an emergency allocation in the amount of \$91,376.92. On February 5, 2023, a frozen & burst pipe at the Field House caused water damages. Request was to cover repair costs.
