

The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in Special Session on Wednesday, June 14, 2023, at 5:15 PM in the Nathaniel Zeno, Jr. Meeting Room, Jackson Parish Administrative Building, 160 Industrial Drive, Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members Present: Mr. Todd Culpepper, Mr. Lewis Chatham, Ms. Amy Magee, Mr. John McCarty, Ms. Tarneshala Cowans, and Mr. Keith Burris. Absent: Ms. Regina Rowe. Also present: Mr. Brad Roller, Operations Manager and Mr. Jody Stuckey, Road Superintendent.

The President, Mr. Culpepper, called the meeting to order. Mr. McCarty gave the invocation and Ms. Magee led in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Culpepper called for public comments and there were none.

The President called for monthly management reports.

Mr. Jody Stuckey, Road Superintendent, presented the May 2023 Road report noting that \$6,613.56 had been spent on emergency call-outs/off-schedule work.

A petition from residents for the placement of speed bumps on Lamkin Road was presented to the police jury, but died for lack of a motion.

Motion by Ms. Magee, second by Ms. Cowans to accept the resignation of Tammy Collinsworth, Accounts Payable Clerk and post the vacancy for seven (7) days and advertise the vacancy. Motion carried.

Motion by Ms. Magee, second by Mr. Chatham to approve \$13,112 to Pine Belt Multi-Purpose Community Action Agency. Motion carried.

Motion by Ms. Cowans, second by Ms. Magee to appoint the Ruston Daily Leader as the Official Journal for the Jackson Parish Police Jury for July 1, 2023, - June 30, 2024. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Chatham, second by Mr. McCarty to authorize the Library Director to advertise and authorize the Library Board to sell the 2005 Blue Bird Bookmobile. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Chatham, second by Mr. Burris to approve overtime for Solid Waste employees on Saturday, June 17, 2023, due to the Juneteenth Holiday on Monday, June 19, 2023. Motion carried.

Motion by Mr. Burris, second by Mr. Chatham to authorize the Secretary-Treasurer to advertise for bids for lighting related to the Energy Grant. Motion carried.

There was no action taken on Parish Board appointments.

Motion by Mr. McCarty, second by Mr. Chatham to adjourn. Motion carried.
