The Finance Committee met Tuesday, December 4, 2018 at 12:10 PM in the Police Jury Meeting Room of the Jackson Parish Courthouse, 500 E. Court Street, Room 301, Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members present: Mr. Todd Culpepper, Mr. John McCarty, and Mr. Lynn Treadway. Absent: none.

The meeting was called to order by the chair, Mr. McCarty.

Mr. Treadway gave the invocation and Mr. McCarty led in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no public comments.

The Committee discussed items for the preliminary 2019 budget.

Motion Mr. Culpepper, seconded Mr. Treadway to recommend the Jury include the following items in the 2019 budget:

- 2019 insurance quotation from The Lincoln Agency for worker's compensation, liability, auto, property, crime, and inland marine for the amount of \$219,032.93.
- General Fund transfer of \$80,000 to Coroner's Fund
- General Fund transfer of \$40,000 to Capital Outlay for work on handicap ramp at the Courthouse
- General Fund transfer of \$360,000 for Certificates of Indebtedness
- Equipment budget of \$351,950 for Road Department
- Equipment budget of \$223,600 for Solid Waste Department

Motion Mr. Culpepper, seconded Mr. Treadway to recommend the Jury increase the salary of the Secretary-Treasurer by \$5,000 annually for additional duties performed as Flood Plain Administrator and official FEMA mapping. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Culpepper, seconded Mr. Treadway to adjourn. Motion carried.

The Jury reviewed budget items as recommended by the Finance Committee.

Motion Mr. Treadway, seconded Mr. Langston to approve the 2019 Insurance quote from The Lincoln Agency of \$219,032.93. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Culpepper, seconded Mr. Treadway to approve General Fund transfers to Coroner \$80k, Capital Outlay \$40k, Certificates of Indebtedness \$360k. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Treadway, seconded Mr. McCarty to approve equipment purchases and leases for the Road and Solid Waste Departments for \$571,950. Motion carried.

Motion Mr. Culpepper, seconded Ms. Cowans to approve the recommended salary increase of \$5,000/year for the Secretary-Treasurer for additional duties performed as Flood Plain Administrator. Mr. Culpepper stated that this is a new workload added to the Jury that has been dictated by FEMA. Motion carried.

Mr. Robin Sessions, Solid Waste Department Superintendent, presented the monthly Solid Waste Report. Motion Mr. Culpepper, seconded Mr. Treadway to accept the November Solid Waste Report. Motion carried.

No O.E.P. Report was given by Mr. Mark Treadway. No action taken.

Ms. Gina Thomas, Secretary-Treasurer, presented the monthly Financial Report to the Jury with discussion on actual to budget comparisons. Motion Mr. Culpepper, seconded Mr. Treadway to accept the November Financial Report. Motion carried.

Mr. Bubba Anderson, Maintenance Department Supervisor, presented the monthly Maintenance Report. He mentioned completed work on Community Center events, boiler repairs, and Christmas decorations. Motion Mr. Treadway, seconded Ms. Cowans to accept the November Maintenance Report. Motion carried.
