The Jackson Parish Police Jury met in Special Session on Thursday, July 28, 2022, at 5:30 PM in the Nathaniel Zeno, Jr. Meeting Room, Jackson Parish Administrative Building, 160 Industrial Drive, Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members Present: Mr. Todd Culpepper, Ms. Amy Magee, Mr. John McCarty, Ms. Regina Rowe, and Mr. Lynn Treadway. Absent: Mr. Lewis Chatham and Ms. Tarneshala Cowans. Also present: Mr. Darrell Avery, Assistant D.A. and Mr. Brad Roller, Operations Manager.

The President, Mr. Treadway, called the meeting to order. Mr. Culpepper gave the invocation and Ms. Magee led in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

Motion by Ms. Rowe, seconded by Mr. McCarty to amend the agenda to include the Secretary/Treasurer having access to the safe deposit box at Jonesboro State Bank. Motion carried unanimously, of the members present, and the item was added as part of agenda item #2.

There were no public comments.

Ms. Rowe stated that the 2% Fire Insurance Rebate funds had been received from the State; therefore, the advance of \$5,000 to the Hodge Fire Protection District would not be necessary. The remittance of the 2% Fire Insurance Rebate funds to the fire protection districts will take place during the week following this meeting.

Mr. Ralph Laffitte, Chairman of the Hodge Fire Protection District, discussed the District's issues regarding the collection of unpaid parcel fees from the residents of the District. He stated that for the past 8 years, the number of unpaid parcel fees have increased from 31 parcels to 237 parcels. Jurors stated that the District needs to take necessary actions to ensure that all unpaid parcel fees are collected.

Motion by Ms. Rowe, seconded by Mr. Culpepper, to authorize the probationary Secretary-Treasurer to be added to the signature card at Jonesboro State Bank for negotiating checks, transferring funds and authorizing/approving payroll ACH transactions, and to sign documents in accordance with the jury's policies, granting full cash management and online banking access and authorization on all police jury accounts at Jonesboro State Bank, and to authorize access to the police jury's safe deposit box.

Motion by Ms. Magee, seconded by Mr. Culpepper to adjourn. Motion carried.
