

Parish Cleanup Committee  
February 27, 2023

The Parish Cleanup Committee met Monday, February 27, 2023, at 4:30 PM in the Nathaniel Zeno, Jr. Meeting Room, Jackson Parish Administrative Building, 160 Industrial Drive, Jonesboro, Louisiana. Members Present: Ms. Amy Magee, and Mr. Lewis Chatham. Absent: Mr. John McCarty. Also present: Mr. Robin Sessions, Solid Waste Superintendent.

The meeting was called to order by Ms. Magee. Ms. Magee gave the invocation and Mr. Chatham led in the recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

There were no public comments.

The Committee discussed different dates for the Parish Cleanup. Since April 22<sup>nd</sup> coincides with the Louisiana Love the Boot Week of April 17-23, 2023, it was decided to set the Parish Cleanup for April 22<sup>nd</sup>.

The Committee assigned to Mr. Sessions the task of obtaining safety vests, grabbers, and trash bags in the same quantities that were on hand last year. A count of the items will be taken and an order will be made to satisfy the quantities needed.

The Committee discussed the meeting time for the participants to meet for their vests, grabbers, and trash bags. It was decided that 7:00 AM will be the time to gather.

Motion by Mr. Chatham, second by Ms. Magee to recommend to the police jury to approve the Parish Cleanup Day to be April 22<sup>nd</sup> that will coincide with the Louisiana Love the Boot Week and the meeting time to be 7:00 AM. Motion carried.

The Committee moved on to Other Cleanup issues.

Mr. Sessions stated that the bin sites will be the location for the Parish Cleanup participants to take their trash bags and Solid Waste employees will empty the bins from 10:00 AM to 3:00 PM on April 22, 2023.

The Committee discussed advertising for the Parish Cleanup Day. Beginning March 18<sup>th</sup>, the Parish Cleanup Day will be advertised in the Jackson Parish Journal, the Jackson Parish Police Jury Facebook page, and the Jackson Parish Police Jury website.

Mr. McCarty arrived at the meeting.

Motion by Mr. Chatham, second by Ms. Magee to adjourn. Motion carried.
