RE: Deerwood Roundabout Center Island – Continued Discussion

This agenda item is a continuation of the ongoing process of determining aesthetic improvements for center island of the Deerwood roundabout. In two previous study session discussions, the Board expressed the desire to have a monument sign and landscaping.

I recently met with Marty Platz of Coast-to-Coast Signs about monument sign options, hoping to learn rough cost estimates for different types of signage. Coast to Coast has provided several attached options, but cannot provide rough estimates for all options. If the Board will select one or two favorites, they will then provide estimates for those signs. Mr. Platz did provide an example cost for a pillar-style sign they previously constructed in downtown Cape. It is shown below. That sign was upwards of \$80,000, including the surrounding block planter.


Once a complete island design is developed, it must be submitted to MODOT for approval, a process which MODOT says may be rather lengthy. They have recommended that we complete a design soon to submit for approval.

Once a sign is selected, landscaping plans can be solicited to complement the signage.






ILLUMINATED NIGHT VIEW





The City requires professional janitorial services to assist its staff with cleaning maintenance at the Jackson Police Station located at 202 West Jackson Boulevard. The contractor will be responsible for the janitorial upkeep and cleanliness of the building (approximately 18,000 s.f). This Program consists of furnishing all labor, tools, equipment, and materials necessary to complete standard periodic janitorial services, including but not limited to cleaning, vacuuming, and other tasks, for a three-year period. The Police Station will be serviced by the contractor on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday between the regular business hours of 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

Attached please find a copy the bid tabulation sheet for the above referenced services program. Only (1) bid was received and opened at City Hall on Tuesday, April 23rd, at 10:00 a.m.

Clean Slate Cleaning Service, of Cape Girardeau, Missouri, is the apparent low bidder at \$1,440.00 per month for a three (3) year period.

The bid has been reviewed by Police Department Administrative Assistant Rachel Coleman, and her recommendation is to award this contract. Therefore, City staff respectfully requests that the Board accept their bid and award the contract on Monday, May 20th in regular session.
