The Jackson R-2 School District is requesting abandonment of one block of West Madison Street and a portion of one block of South Oklahoma Street to allow them the ability to provide better security for events at the football stadium.

Dr. Keenan Kinder will be at the study meeting to present their request.

Easements will need to be retained to allow access to utilities as well as an agreement to provide gate keys to city utility departments who may need to respond to emergency utility issues. A Memorandum of Understanding would be appropriate.

Dear Jackson Board of Aldermen,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to respectfully request that the Board of Aldermen consider allowing the Jackson R2 School District to take over the section of W. Madison Street adjacent to Jackson Sr High School and the football stadium. This request stems from a growing concern for the safety of our students, staff, and visitors, as well as our ongoing efforts to enhance the overall campus environment.

The section of W. Madison Street in question currently runs directly next to our high school campus and the football stadium, an area that is often frequented by students, parents, and spectators during school events. Particularly on game days, the current infrastructure poses significant safety risks.

By assuming responsibility for this portion of the street, our school district would be able to make necessary improvements that directly benefit both our school community and the surrounding neighborhood. Specifically, we plan to:

- 1. **Enhance safety** by creating a concourse around the south side of the stadium where our weapons detectors might be utilized.
- 2. Improve lighting around the stadium on the south side.
- 3. **Expand the high school campus** with student-friendly areas that contribute to a safer and more inviting environment.


4. Ensure ongoing maintenance and improvements tailored specifically to the needs of our school community.



Dear Mr. Seabaugh and Ms. Liley,

I live in Ward 3, on Jonathan Dr. on the west side of Jackson. I would like you to consider, study and then propose creating a school zone on Oak Street between West Lane and Elwanda Streets. Currently the speed limit is either 15 miles per hour or 20 miles per hour depending on where you are on Oak Street. I believe these speed zones are reasonable and required for safety when school is in session. I am requesting that you make that area 30 miles per hour during non school hours. Going 15 miles per hour at 5:30 in the morning on the way to the gym is difficult, as you have to ride the car's brakes going downhill.

We have school zone speed limits at other parts of town. I appreciate that area includes many schools and many students, busses, parents and other traffic coming and going. But, during the summer and other times when school is not in session, the standard 30 miles per hour seems reasonable.

I hope you will consider my request, or at least study it.

The proposed Change Order No. 3, in the amount of \$50,289.96, is comprised of the seven (7) items listed above. Generally, these items are the result of conditions discovered during the demolition phase of the project. Comments in addition to the information attached to this memorandum are included below.

COR 008- Lintels for Windows in Existing Walls (RFI 22)

Demolition of existing wall at new window locations (14 windows) exposed the original construction and it was determined that additional masonry work and installation of steel lintels at the various window locations would be required to assure a tight and sturdy window installation.

COR 009- EMS Storage Room 140 Shoring Ceiling and Enclosure Ceiling Opening (RFI 18)

Room 140 is designated as EMS equipment storage room. Physical conditions at the point where a new wall meets the roof were determined inadequate for support of the roof and a new steel beam was required to provide for adequate support at that location.

COR 003- P-3 Walls on South and East Walls of Training Room 001

A revision to the finished wall construction in training Room 001 on the south and east walls is required to accommodate a sewer stack and provide a central location to reinstall an existing smart board. Walls were originally intended to be painted drywall but are modified to utilize a new stud wall bump out to allow for installation of the smart board.

COR 011- Stair 1 Wall Height (RFI 20)

The existing wall was determined to be too low for proper installation of a new handrail at the proper height to meet the applicable codes.

COR 002- Lav Shields in Place of Lav Guards on P3 Fixtures

Upgraded guards to protect plumbing under various sinks.

COR 007- Shower Bases (RFI 17)

Upgraded shower bases in anticipation of heavy use to increase the durability and life expectancy in anticipation of heavy use.

COR 010- Floor Sink in Basement Mechanical Room (RFI 23) The existing floor drain in the basement mechanical room was found to be inadequate for the three drains in that portion of the building. A floor sink is proposed to replace the existing floor drain.

City staff recommends that the Mayor and Board of Aldermen approve the proposed Change Order No.3 for the Building Addition & Renovation of Jackson Fire Station #1 project in the amount of \$50,289.96.

Please reference Window Head Detail (Existing Wall) 14/A3.4. This detail shows an existing CMU bond beam at the top of the new window. Drawing A2.1 shows the top of the windows to be at 7'-10" above the floor. While demoing the new openings, it was found that the existing CMU bond beam is roughly 8'-8" above the floor, which is 10" higher then the proposed top of window. Please see attached picture of a new opening onsite with added comments. There are no steel lintels called out on the drawings for these openings either. Please advise how this 10" gap between the bottom of the bond beam and the top of the window should be infilled.

Please note that the Pella windows have already been made and are sitting in the installer's warehouse.



For the steel lintels for the new window openings in the existing 6" CMU block walls of the office building use the following:

•(2) L 2 1/2 x 2 1/2 x 5/16 angles back to back (window width 5'-0" - window type C)

•(2) L 2 1/2 x 2 1/2 x 1/4 angles back to back (window width 3'-4" or smaller - window types A, B, & D)

The pair of steel lintels can be connected bolted @ 32" o.c. per the cover sheet instructions or welded (1" per 12" of angle) and the angles can be painted with galvanized paint.

Dear Mr. Harris,

Floor plan drawing A1.1 does not call out for the South and East walls of Training Room 001 to be furred out with drywall, but the finish schedule on A4.1 calls out for these walls to be painted drywall. After a site visit it was determined there is also a 4" sewer stack that needs to be covered on the South wall. Penzel plans to install a 3-5/8" stud wall bump out to cover this sewer stack and allow the smart board to be installed in the center of the room. The remaining South and East walls of this room will be furred out with 1-1/2" hat channel. See attached sketch showing the proposed plan. Penzel requests to be compensated for this change in scope in the amount of \$3,261.72.






