

















### **GCHS TIMELINE**

2000 - National Historic Lighthouse Preservation Act


2002 - Sentinel Island Light Station listed on National Register

2004 - GCHS selected to obtain deed to Sentinel Island Light Station


2006 - Quit Claim deed transferred to GCHS

### **Grant One**

Program: Maritime Heritage Preservation (MHP)

Grantee: National Park Service – Department of the Interior

Project: Rehabilitation of Support Buildings at Sentinel Island Light Station

### **Grant Two**

Program: Historic Preservation Funds (HPF)
Grantee: National Park Service – Department of the Interior
Project: Sentinel Island Lighthouse Exterior Rehabilitation
