

BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS

A meeting of the Board of Public Works was called to order by Chair Antoine on Tuesday, August 18, 2026, at 6:30 P.M.

Alders present: Antoine, DeCoster, Eggleston, Kilgas, Moore, Schell, Schumacher, and Thiele.

Also present: Mayor Penterman, DPW/Eng. Neumeier, Fire Chief Carrel, Street Superintendent Van Gompel, Mark. and Com. Manager Fencel (Zoom), Police Chief Graff, and interested citizens.

2. Discussion Topics.

a. Recommendation for Award of Proposal for Quiet Zone Improvement Materials.

There was one proposal submitted and opened on August 5, 2026, for the materials needed to complete the quiet zone upgrades. Rent-A-Flash, the sole participating supplier, is a company where the city purchases most sign materials. The quiet zone implementation has been requested for several years from various neighborhoods.

Motion made by Moore, seconded by Kilgas to authorize the Street Superintendent to award proposal from Rent-A-Flash of Wisconsin Inc. for the quiet zone improvement materials for \$27,577.12

b. Recommendation for Award of Proposal for the Debris Removal at the Tower Drive Storm Lift Station.

On August 5, 2026, the Street Department opened proposals for the debris removal from the Tower Drive storm lift station. Speedy Clean Drain and Sewer and Great Lakes TV Seal Inc. were the two contractors that submitted proposals. Initial cost estimates mirror what was submitted in both contractors' proposals.

Motion made by Thiele, seconded by Schell to authorize the Street Superintendent to award proposal for the debris removal of the Tower Drive storm lift station to Speedy Clean Drain and Sewer for \$29,700

c. Application for Sidewalk Builders License - DELRAR, Inc.

Motion made by Eggleston, seconded by DeCoster to approve the application for Sidewalk Builders License – DELRAR Inc.

d. Public Works Updates.

DPW/Eng. Neumeier gave some public works updates. There was the first traffic management meeting for the I-41 project and Kaukauna will start to be affected by construction in 2027. The 2026 application to the land and water conservation fund grant was not chosen.

Street Superintendent Van Gompel also gave some public works updates. Van Gompel thanked the Kaukauna football varsity head coach and the student athletes who recently helped at the Kaukauna parks.
