a. Building Permit Fee Update.

Staff have taken time to review the existing fee structure for building permits and are recommending the following fee changes to be more reflective of the cost to the city for review and inspection: Accessory Structure Demolition: Introduce a separate fee of \$50 (accessory structure demolitions are currently included under general building demolition at \$200). Decks: Increase fee from \$60 to \$100 (due to review time and multiple inspections required). Detached Garage: Increase fee from \$100 to \$130 (due to review time and multiple inspections required). Patios: Introduce a new permit fee of \$60 (currently no permit is required, but review of setbacks and lot coverage is still needed). Storage Shed: Increase fee from \$60 to \$80 (due to review time and multiple inspections required). Swimming Pool: Increase fee from \$60 to \$80 (due to review time and multiple inspections required)

Motion by Moore, seconded by Eggleston, to recommend approval of the building permit fee update to the Common Council.
